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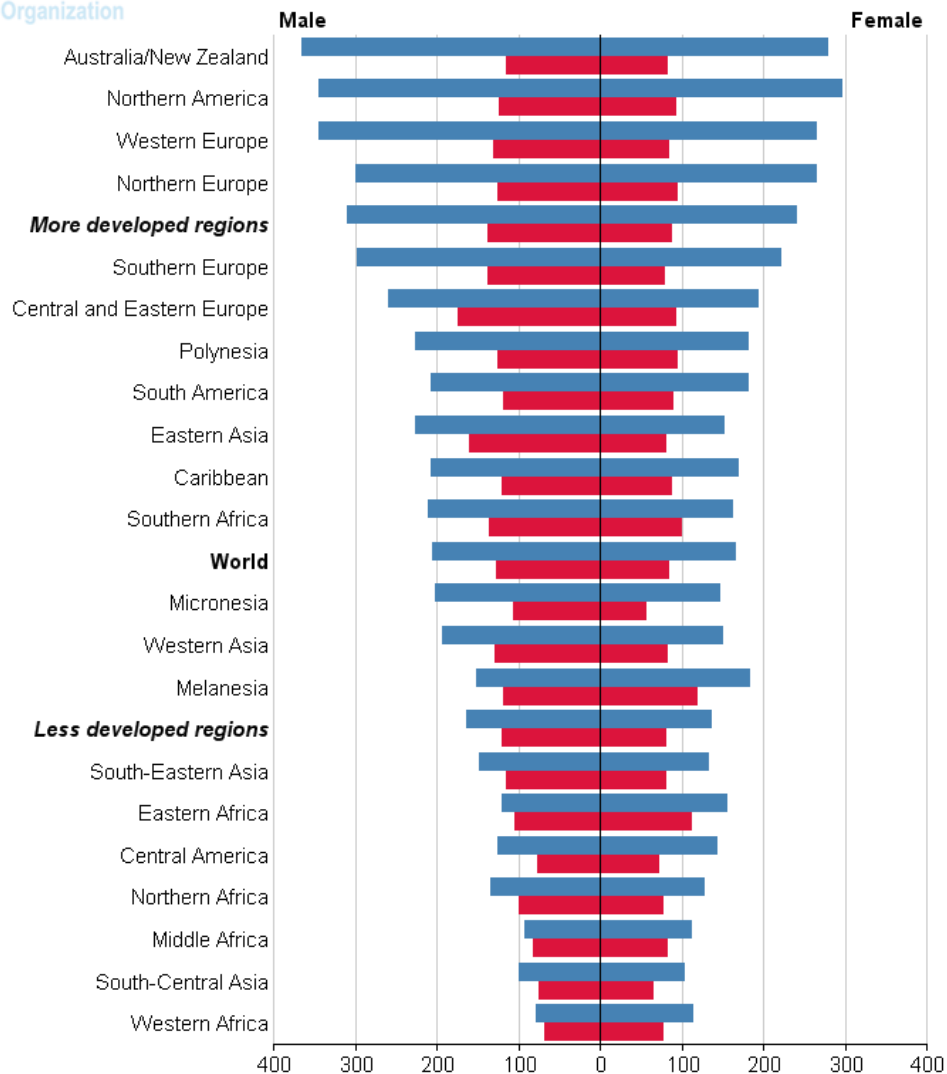


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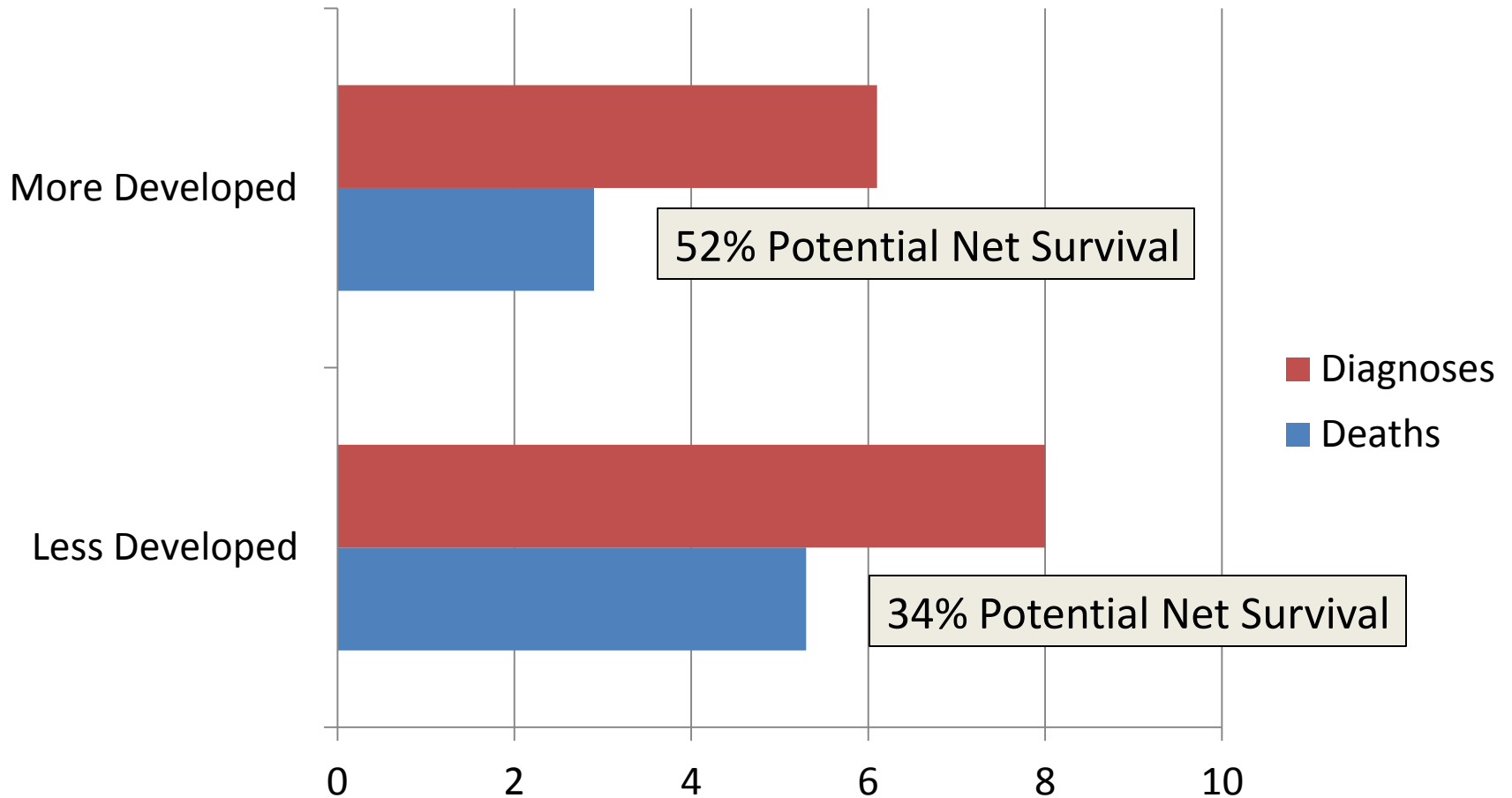

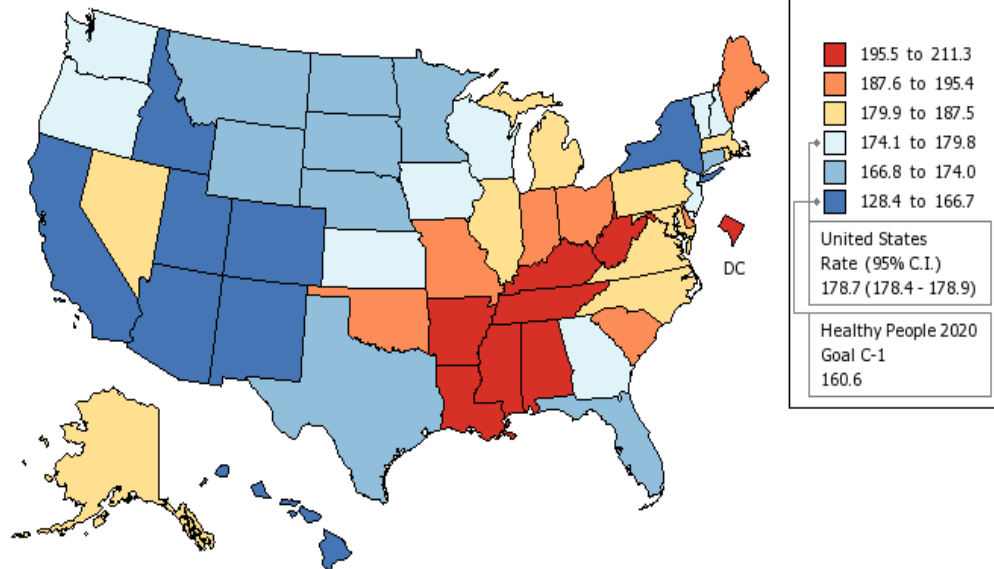


Cancer Diagnosis and Mortality Worldwide More vs. Less Developed Nations (millions)

Death rates (deaths per 100,000 population per year) are age-adjusted to the [2000 US standard population](#) (19 age groups: <1, 1-4, 5-9, ..., 80-84, 85+). The Healthy People 2020 goals are based on rates adjusted using different methods but the differences should be minimal.

Population counts for denominators are based on the Census 1969-2009 US Population Data File as modified by NCI.

The US populations included with the data release have been adjusted for the population shifts due to hurricanes

- **Emotional**
 - fear of recurrence
 - depression /anxiety
 - body image
- **Physical**
 - recurrence
 - second cancers
 - other disease (CVD, diabetes, obesity)
 - sarcopenia/bone loss
 - functional decline
- **Financial**
 - cost of care
 - denial of coverage
 - loss of productivity/jobs
