- Non-Mandatory Reporting
- Substantiation 23%

Survey of Geriatricians in Scotland and Ireland

- **261 – 40% Response**
- **Personal Neglect**
- **Refusal of Services**
- **Non-compliance**
- **Element of Abuse - 40%**
- **Males more than females**

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Elder Abuse and Neglect: A Survey of Irish General Practitioners

- **800 G.Ps Surveyed**
- **25% Response Rate**
- **Self-neglect Most Common**
- **Home Visits Detection Site**
- **70% Respondents Felt Situation Improved**

- **13/22 - 68% Response**
- **92% - Case in Past Year**
- **59% - Unsatisfactory for Victim**
- **72% - Unsatisfactory for M.D.**
- **Dementia Most Common**
