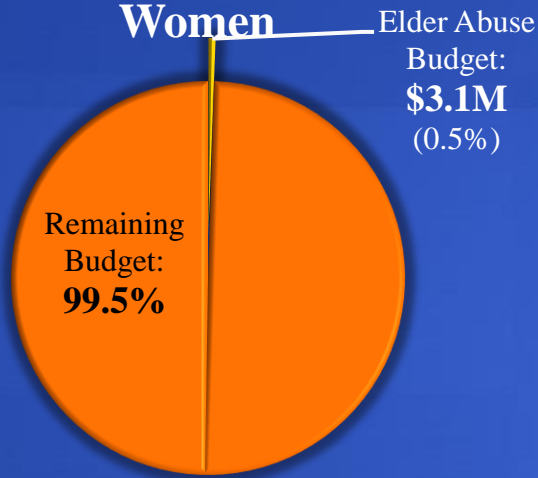

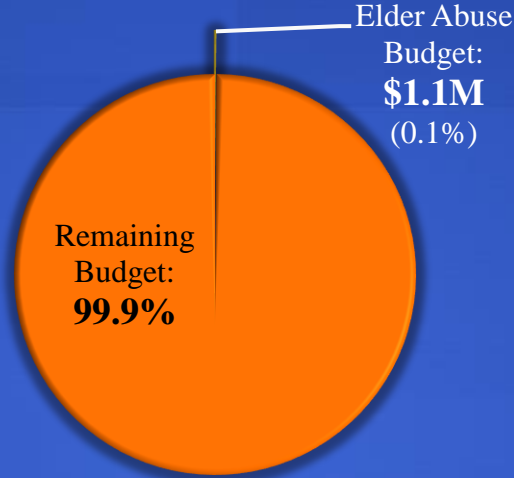

# EXPENDITURES BY FEDERAL AGENCIES TO ADDRESS ELDER ABUSE, NEGLECT AND EXPLOITATION

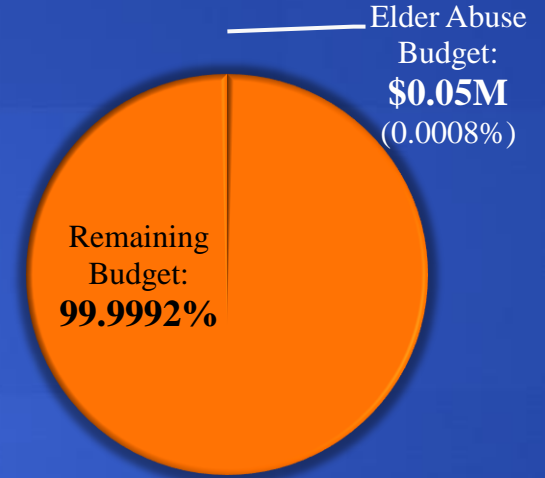
