Since 1962, the **Air Force Studies Board (AFSB)** has served as the principal interface between the Department of the Air Force (DAF) and the National Academies on issues related to science, technology, engineering, defense acquisition, logistics and sustainment, and human capital in support of Air and Space Force missions.

- ▶ Our evidence-based strategic analysis spans across the acquisition lifecycle from requirements definition to sustainment and provides clarity for decision making on high-level issues such as force modernization, systems integration, and mission-focused capability development.
- ▶ Our studies provide peer-reviewed, actionable recommendations to support strategic-level decision making. Recent work has included insights on topics ranging from artificial intelligence test and evaluation capabilities for the Air Force Test Center to mechanisms for accelerating acquisition timelines for the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force (Acquisition, Technology and Logistics).
