



Clinical Follow-Up and Care for Those Impacted by the JP-5 Releases at Red Hill:

Summaries of Monthly Meetings Between Community Liaisons and National Academies Staff

1. Kick-Off Meeting (February 3, 2025)

The session introduced the National Academies study on clinical follow-up and care for those impacted by the Red Hill JP-5 releases, outlined the unique role of community liaisons, reviewed the study's goals and scope, and answered initial questions about the study process.

2. Second Meeting (March 17, 2025)

This session reflected on the first public committee meeting, introduced new liaison members, discussed plans for upcoming virtual listening sessions and community engagement activities, and strategized ways for liaisons to contribute to future events.

3. Third Meeting (April 28, 2025)

The session provided updates on the study timeline, discussed outcomes from the first virtual listening sessions (public health and mental health), previewed the upcoming pediatric listening session and Hawai'i site visit, and gathered liaison feedback on strengthening community engagement.
