



Gender Diversity of LGBTQ Youth




Sexuality Diversity of LGBTQ Youth




Racial/Ethnic Diversity of LGBTQ Youth




Conversion 'Therapy' Bans: State





Conversion 'Therapy' Bans: Local






- State is in federal judicial circuit with a preliminary injunction currently preventing enforcement of conversion therapy bans (3 states, 0 territories)
- Percent of the state population protected from conversion therapy by local ordinances






Bans on Trans Youth Participation in Sports

Taken Together: Patchwork of Youth Policies






Impacts of Policies on LGBTQ Youth


Supportive school environments, including inclusive curriculum, suicide prevention, and affirming staff, improve students' mental health.


Broader LGBTQ discussions have an impact, such as ballot measures, non-youth focused laws, and even bills that don't pass.
