- Unpredictability
- Lack of equity of resources
- No cohesive plan of action (local, state, nation)
- The unknown risks
- Emotional and physical struggles
- Grief and loss (racial too)
- Layers of trauma

Issues and Opportunities

- Lack of Internet availability
- Incomplete or non-existent IEP service implementation
- Inconsistent school protocols
- Lack of emotional supports offered
- Unequal division of resources
- Racial tensions
- Lack of learning gains

What Do Students Need?

- Consistency
- Predictability
- Safe spaces
- Someone to talk to/with
- Designated emotional support staff
- Social-Emotional supports

What about the Future?

- Collaboration between schools and community service providers
- Training, training, training (educators, families, providers)
- Engage, Educate, Empower
- Free flow of information between families and schools AND schools and service providers
- ► Long term strategic planning for future crises
- Social-Emotional awareness across all systems
