- The Emergency Preparedness Conference (EPC) is held annually and before the start of Hurricane Season.
- Attendance includes:

 - Families of persons with disabilities

 - Community Partners
- Locations for the conference have included:
 - Public Library
 - Conference and Convention Centers
 - Currently it is held at Duval County Public Schools Conference Center known as the Schultz Center



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- CIL Jacksonville conducts planning meetings with community partners including the City of Jacksonville, FEMA, and the Red Cross.
- Since the COVID Pandemic, CIL Jacksonville has adapted the event to be held in a hybrid format of face-to-face and virtual.
- Registration is completed prior to event to verify if accommodations are needed.

EPC WORKBOOK



- All participants receive a Emergency Preparedness Workbook.
- During the EPC, CIL Jacksonville presents how to complete the workbook and important documents that should be kept together in a waterproof/fire resistant container.
- Participants can schedule appointments with CIL staff to complete their individual workbooks at anytime.
- CIL Staff also visit Emergency Plans during new consumer intakes for services at the agency.
