## **Policy Implications and Needed Reforms**

- 1. Payor advocacy reform regarding autism spectrum disorder diagnosis
  - current insurer practices create diagnostic and treatment bottlenecks that increase inequities
- Federal and/or state funding to support professional development of generalists so they can provide appropriate supports and services in their local clinical practices
- 3. Intentional integration of disability best practices within general clinical education & training
