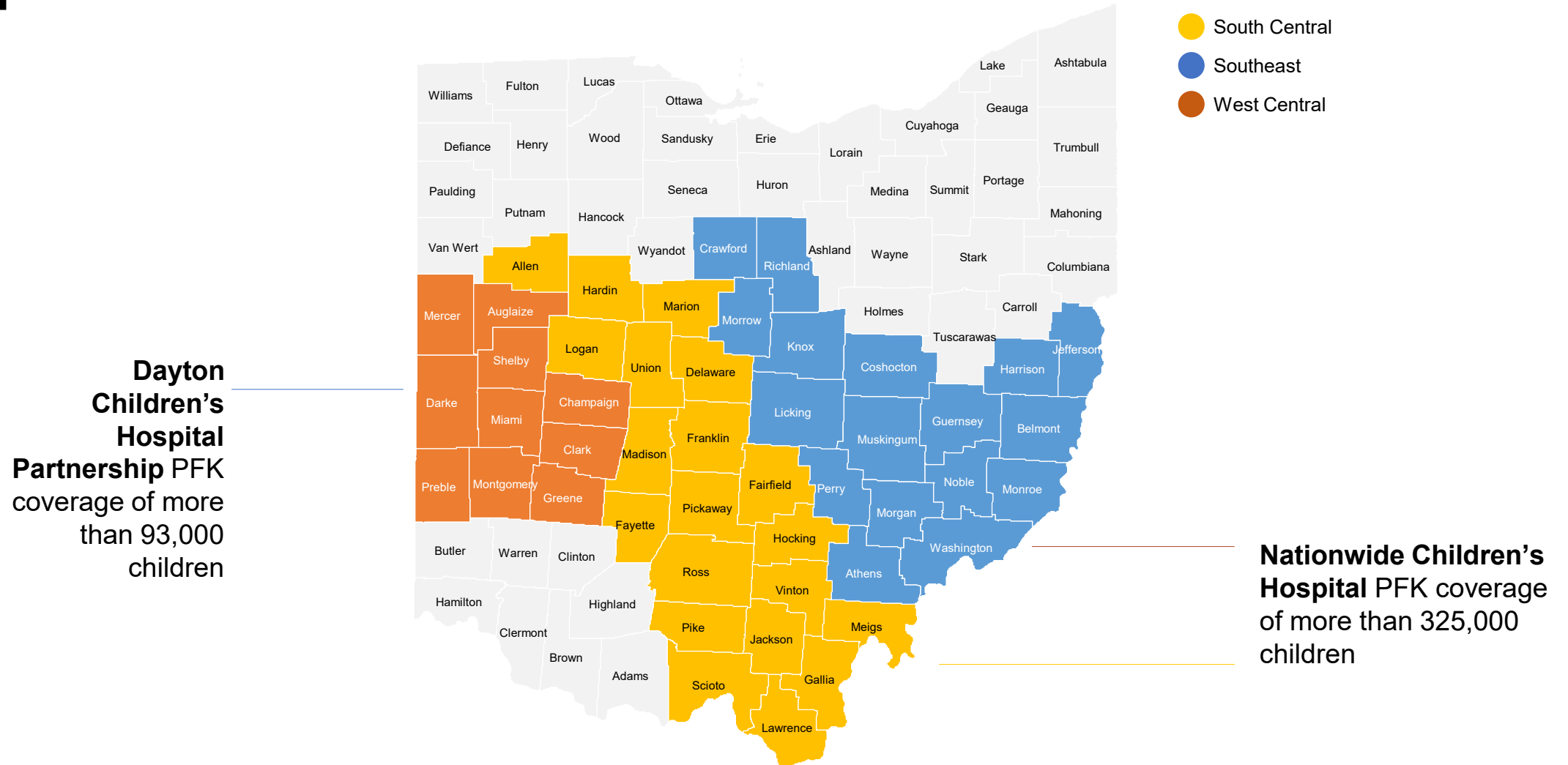

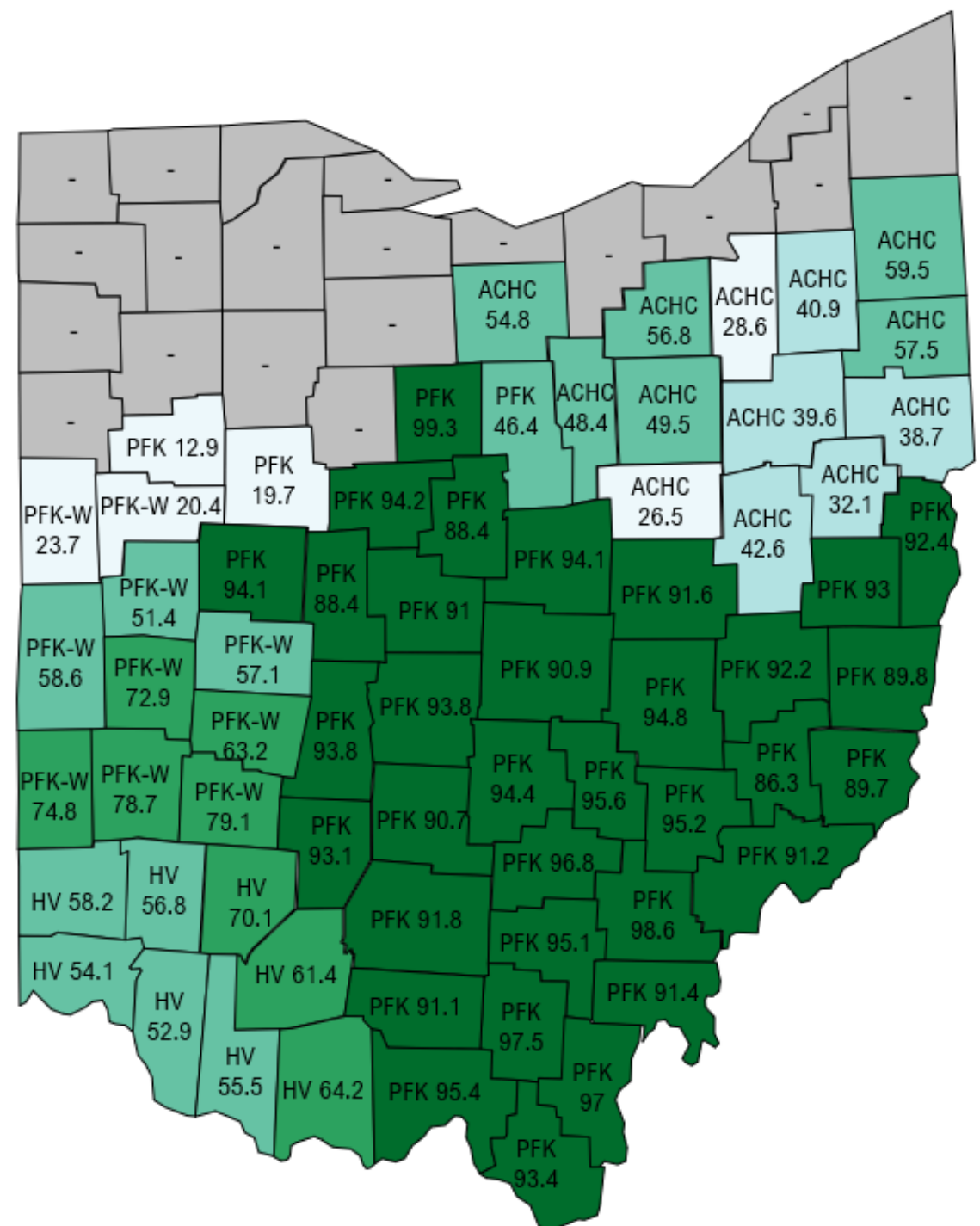

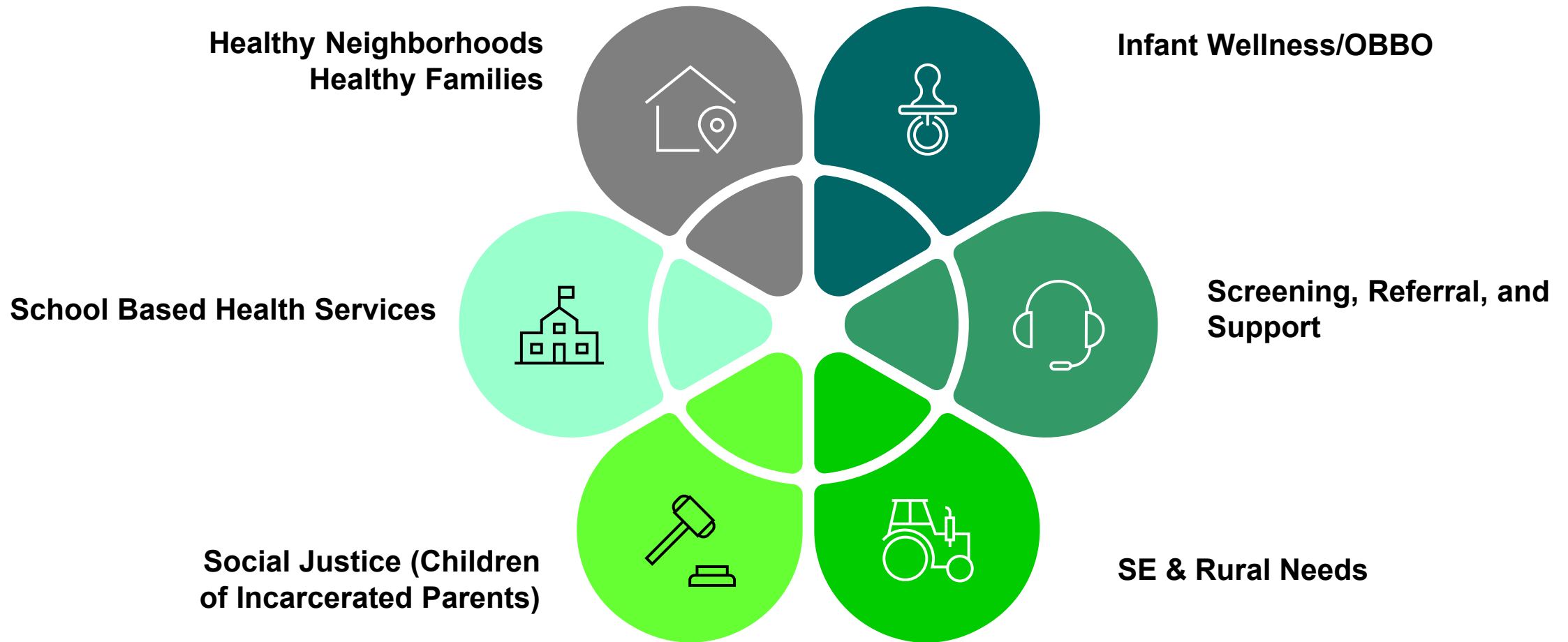
Ohio ACO Coverage by County:

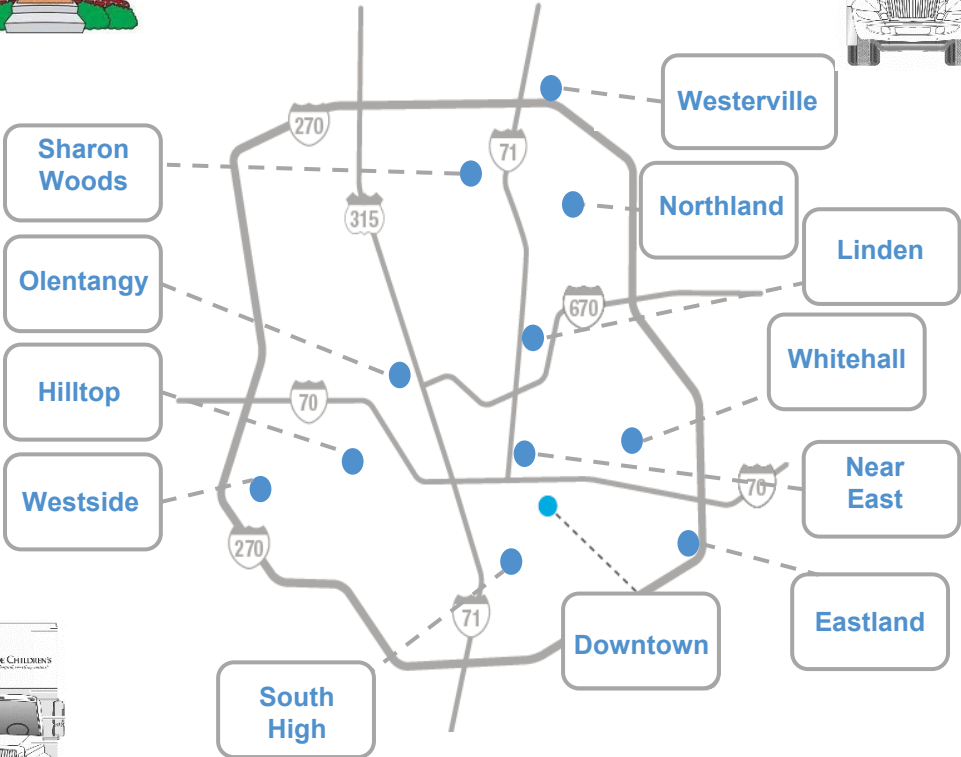

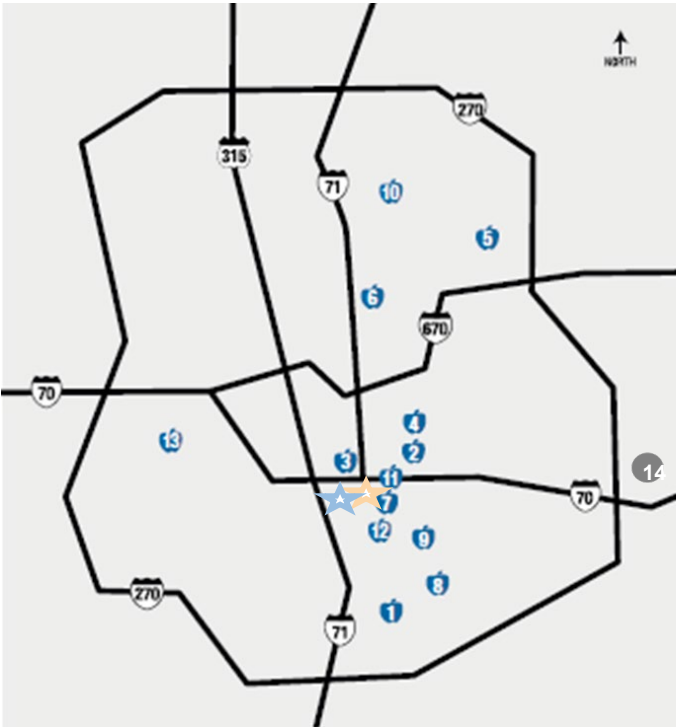

School Health Centers 	Primary Care	 - Well-child care, sick visits, chronic disease management, teen health, vaccine clinics - Primary care mental health
	Vaccinations	 - COVID - Missed vaccinations in 2020
	Vision Center	 - Comprehensive vision exams and access to optical shop for corrective eyewear and fittings - Medical eye care for ophthalmology clinic
	School Nursing	 - Screening services, education, medication administration, social support, referral management - Chronic disease management, individualized health plans
	Behavioral Health	 - Classroom prevention, wellness exams & screenings - Group therapy, provider consults - Direct therapy care and diagnostic tele-consult

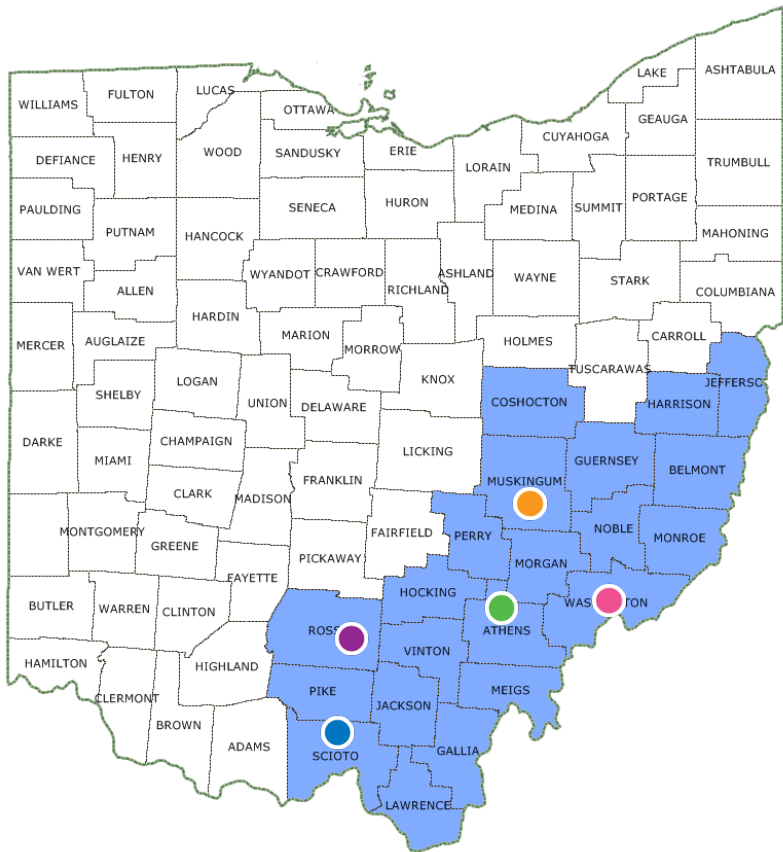


Locations depicted currently have both school-based primary care and BH

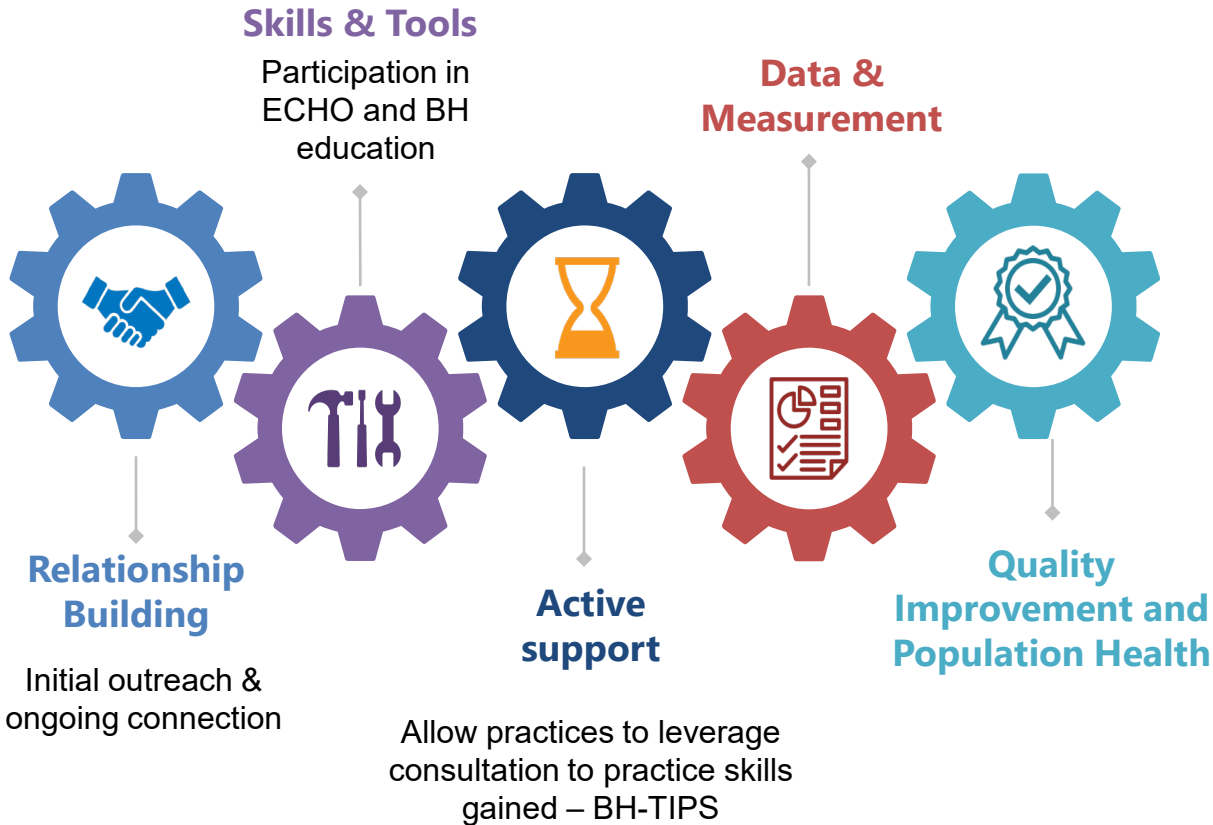

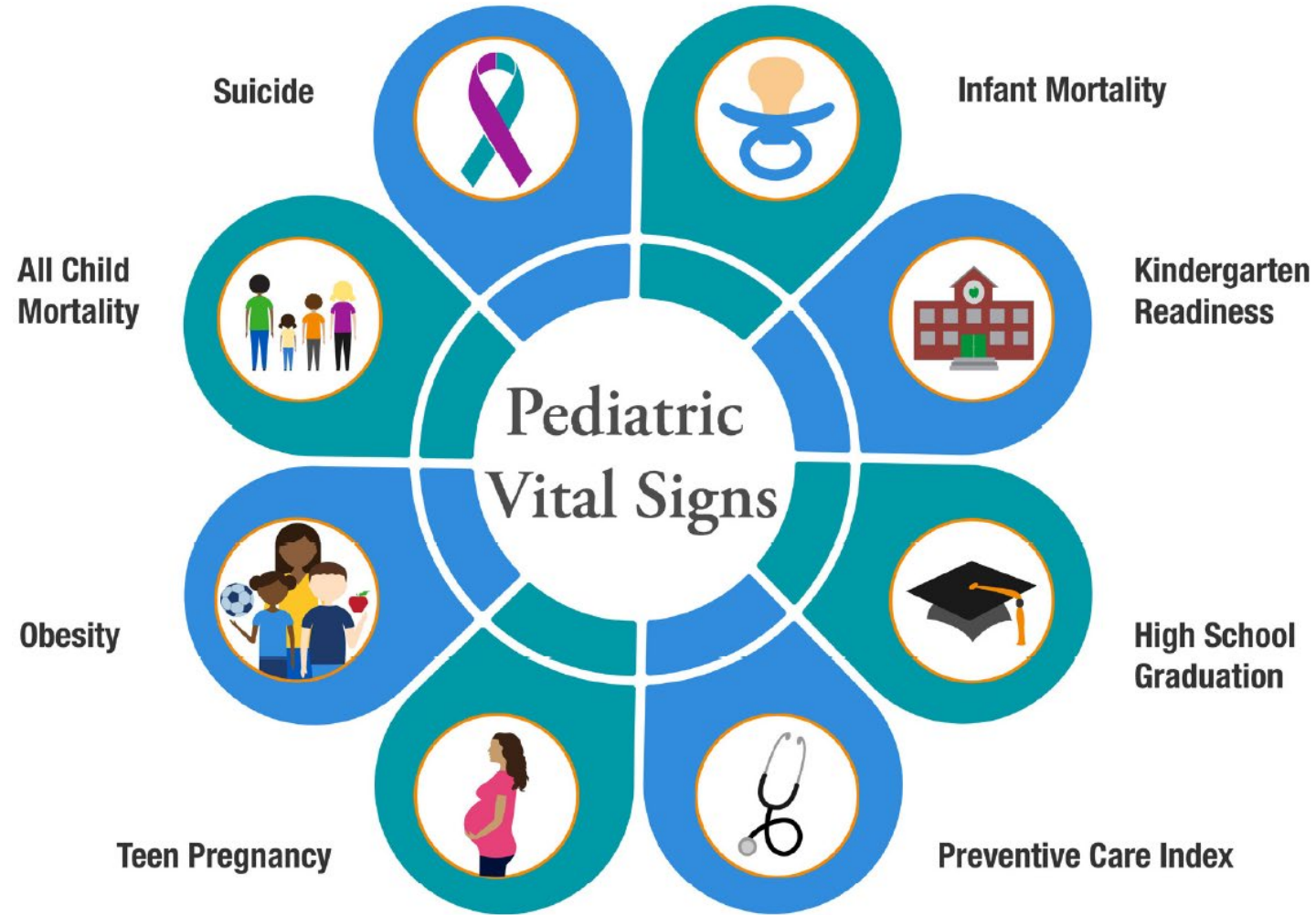


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Investment Sources - Linden
