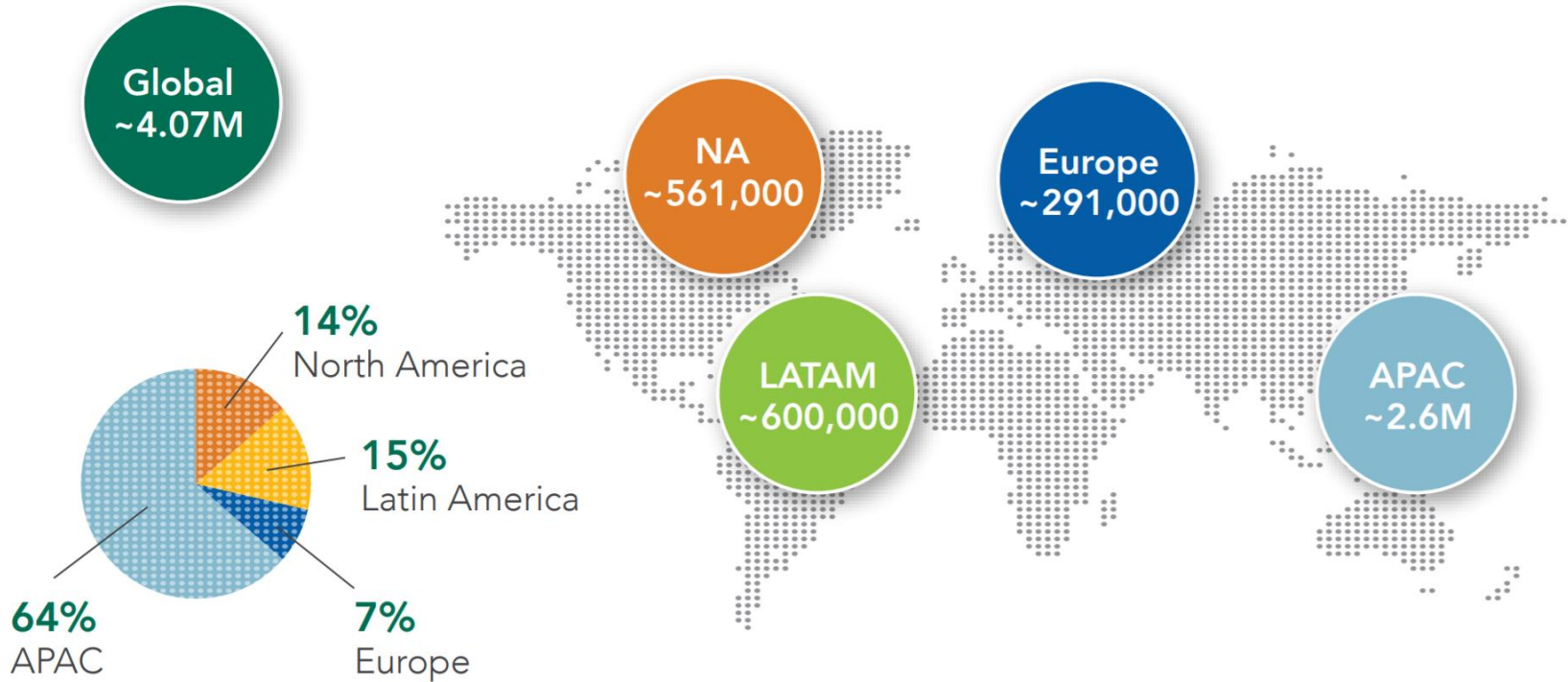

      - using its network of members, partners and sponsors.

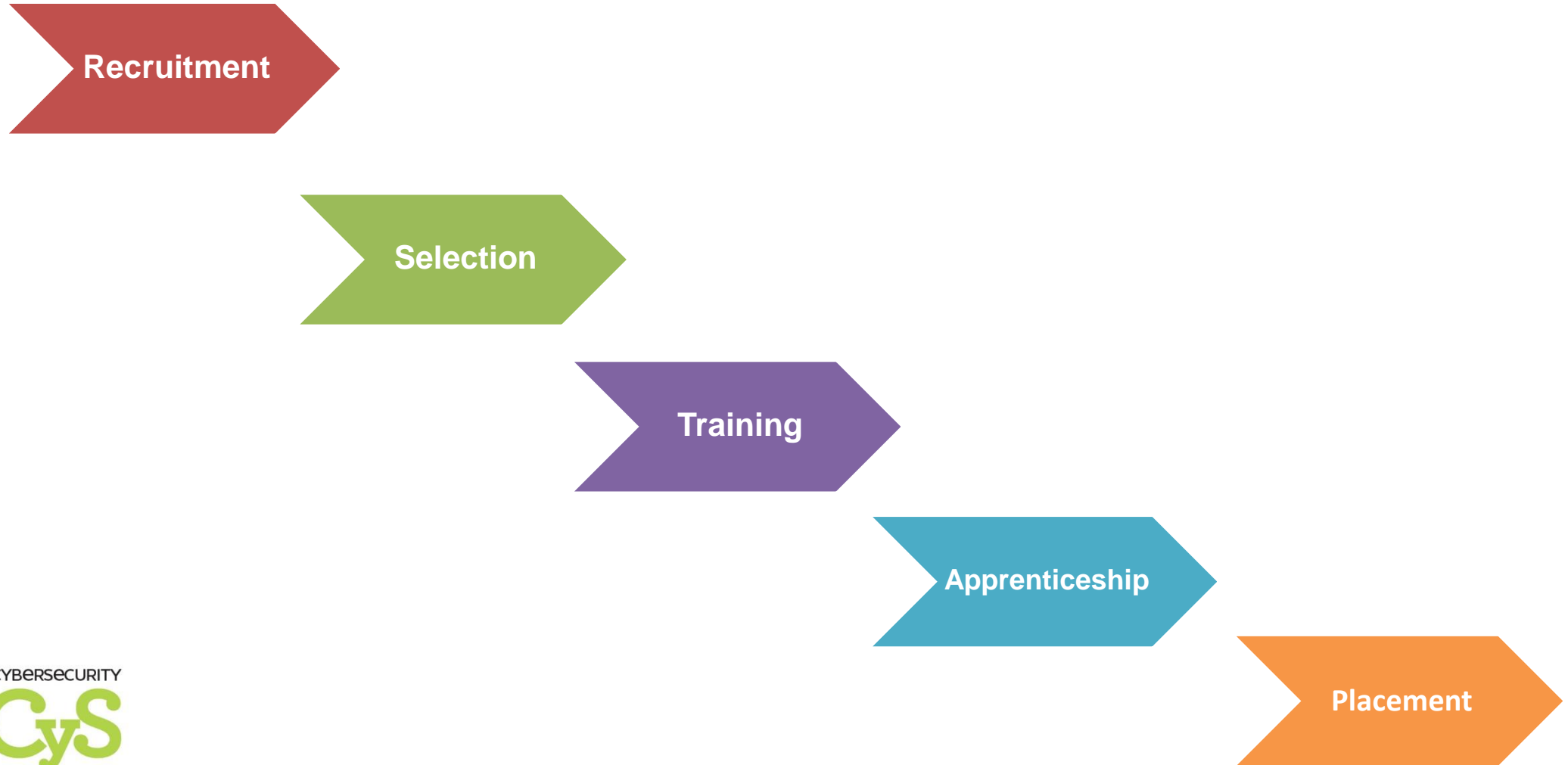
# VAP Activities - 1
