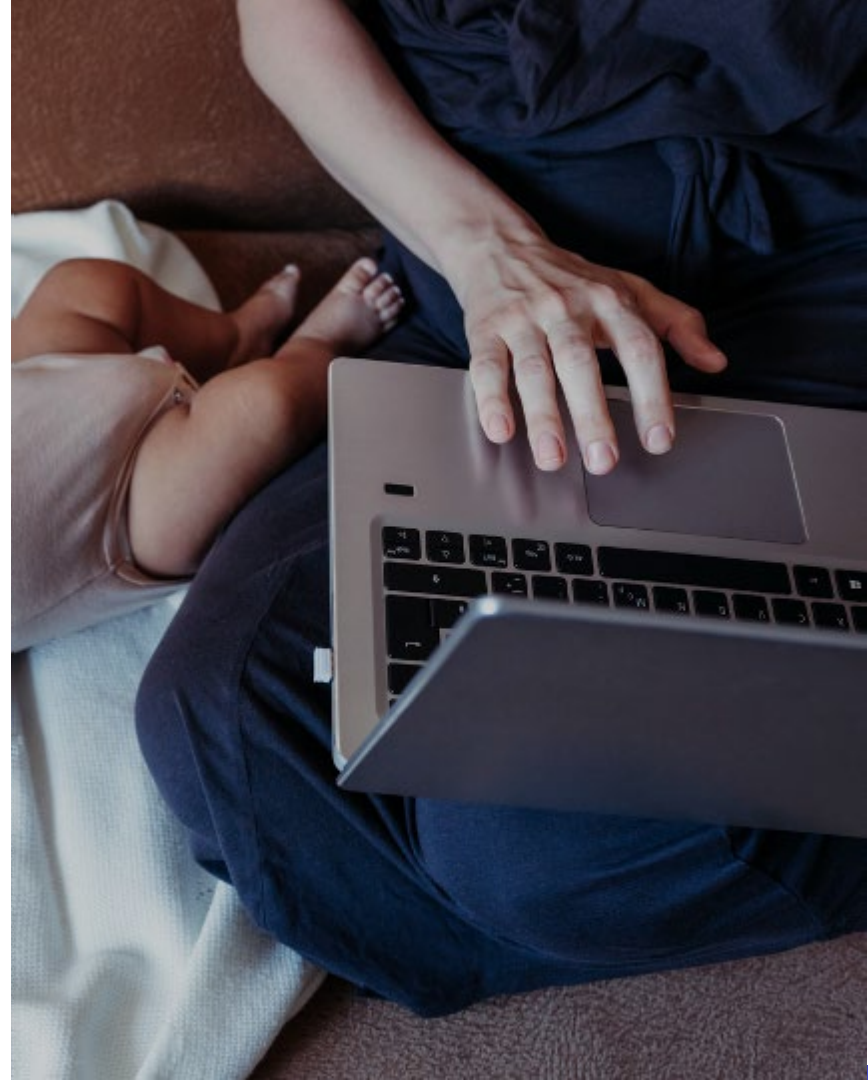

81% of Employers agree

74% of Gen Z agree “I want to learn skills that prepare me for jobs that will be in demand in the future.”

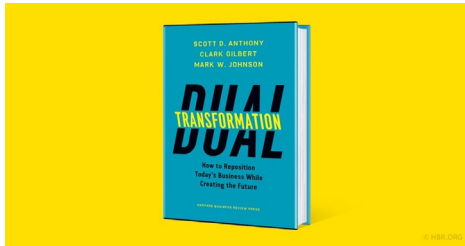
“DC Insiders” agree that non-degree pathways can diversify options for students (93%) and provide skills to meet employer needs (89%).
