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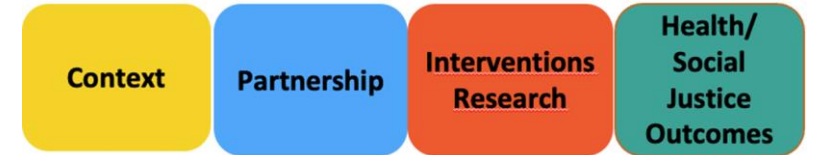

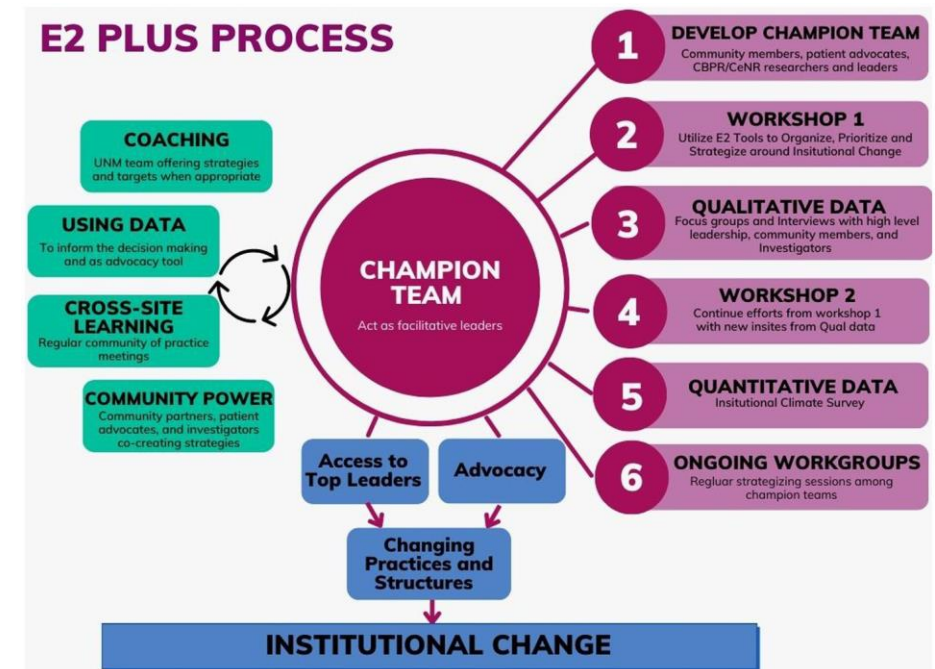


Noted major institutional challenges in supportive practices and structures for community academic partnerships

- Assessing institutional context using mixed methods
 - Engaging community members
 - Community engaged researchers and staff
 - Institutional leadership
- Workshop for iterative evaluation and collective reflection
- Establishing strategic priorities
- Working groups to improve practices and structures



Supporting Science of Engagement



- Institutional changes with three academic health institutions
 - Recognition of community leadership
 - Patient engagement office
 - IRB review, community compensation
- Preliminary work with Mayo Clinic with a Playbook, trainings, and infrastructure
- Continued work with eight Clinical Translational Science Centers through Science of Engagement Award (Wallerstein & Sanchez-Youngman)
