

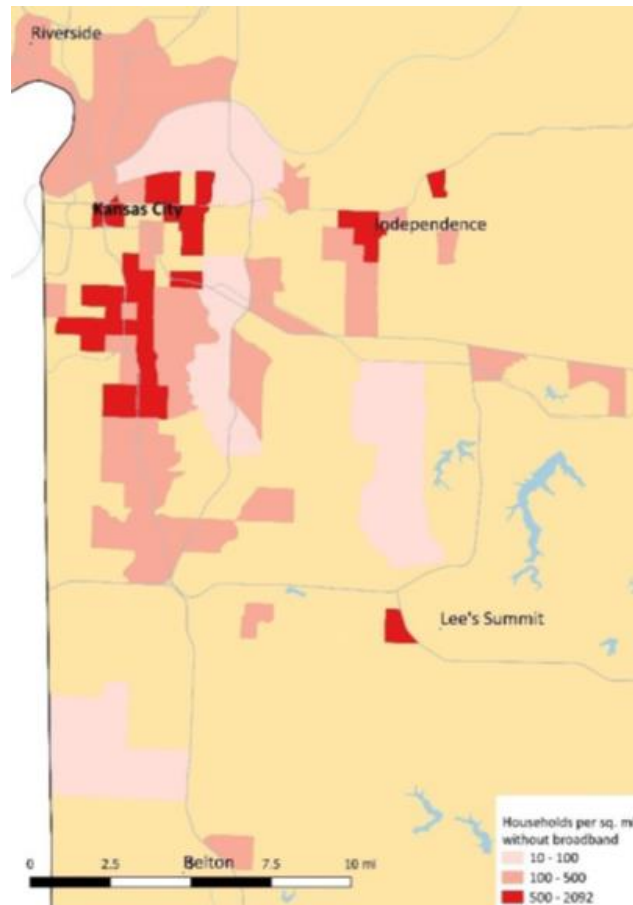
Crossing the Divide:
