# Funding for Services to Native Children and Elderly

 Counts of children eligible for child care and development programs go down over 50% for the 12 reservations in Washington with less than 500 AI/AN alone persons

 By over 33% for the elderly programs in those reservations

### Consequences of Low Counts

Indian and Alaska Native Tribes and organizations have launched a major effort to get an accurate count in 2020

If the Census Bureau provides inaccurate and lower counts, those Tribes and organizations will consider it as a breach of faith

#### **Solutions**

- Allocate a major portion of the privacy budget to smaller populations in small areas
- Change the fund allocation formulas in ways that overcome the disadvantage
- Fund tribal governments to do their own data collection, tabulation and reporting
