




# Vaccination providers need to understand the unique needs of our community

#### Responses per capita






How soon will you get a COVID-19 vaccination?






## LGBTQ+ people of color are more likely to wait to be vaccinated

How soon will you get a COVID-19 vaccination?




### Protecting the community encourages "waiters" to get vaccinated






## Protecting the community is particularly important among LGBTQ+ people

Why will you/did you get vaccinated?




Previous bad experiences with the health system: important among sexual and gender minority people

### Multiple aspects of COVID-19 vaccination remain unclear to all groups


