ZOOM INSTRUCTIONS

To join:

1. Click on the link: <https://nasem.zoom.us/j/125265810>
2. You will be redirected to the Zoom website where you will be prompted to “Run” the Zoom program. Click “Run”. The processing might take a few seconds.
3. Once the Zoom program is launched in a separate window, and you have “entered” the meeting, you should be prompted to join the audio part of the web-conference (if not, click “Join Audio”).
4. Use the “Call Me” tab, enter your phone number, and the system will call to connect you. You will be automatically muted upon entry. Alternatively:
 - a. You can also use the “phone” tab and dial in:
 - i. 1 646 558 8656 or 1 877 853 5257 (Toll Free). International numbers available: <https://zoom.us/j/125265810>.
 - ii. When prompted enter the Meeting ID: 125 265 810.
 - iii. You will also be invited to enter your Participant ID to link your computer to your phone audio. This personalized ID will appear in the pop-up window that includes the meeting ID and phone numbers.
 - b. “Join by Computer”: for this option we highly encourage you to use a headset to avoid background noise and feedback noise. Once you click on this option will be directly connected to the audio part of the web-conference.

5. Once you join the meeting, you will see a window with several options and many more icons at the bottom of the window (once you move the cursor to the bottom of the window, you will see the icons). You can choose to use a camera, mute your line, see participant list, etc.
