

## VISTAS IN CATALYSIS

Call for presentations in catalysis for a National Academies of Science, Engineering and Medicine Workshop:

The National Academies Chemical Sciences Roundtable is soliciting short presentations for an upcoming workshop entitled [Innovations in Catalysis to Address Modern Challenges](#). The workshop will be held on October 24-25th as an in-person and virtual hybrid event, open to all. The organizers hope to provide a forum to share emerging results to a wide and diverse audience of chemists and chemical engineers. Researchers from around the globe with affiliations in academia, industry, government labs, and/or independent research organizations are all encouraged to submit. The workshop spans applications of catalysis to fine chemical, pharmaceutical, agrochemical and materials synthesis, and aims to cover research on new catalyst discoveries, new applications of catalysis, and new techniques for understanding catalytic mechanisms. The organizing committee will select topics based on the range of responses to this call for submissions. The committee reserves the right to accept or reject topics at their discretion.

Selected participants will be provided a virtual and in-person forum for sharing results. The format will be a rapid-fire session with each participant given 3-minutes (strictly enforced) for presentation. Pre-recorded presentations will be encouraged. Following the session, there will be a breakout session for discussion open to all participants and presenters.
