

## **Euro 7 & UNECE: Setting tire abrasion limits**





2024

> EU adopted Euro 7 regulation – introduced limits on tire abrasion to reduce microplastics from tires and brakes.

Euro 7 will take up tire abrasion limits to be established by United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE).

2024

UNECE Working Party on Noise and Tyres created new Task Force on Tyre Abrasion.

2030

> Agree testing methodology and establish abrasion limits for different class tires: passenger vehicles (2026), light commercial vehicles (2028), heavier commercial vehicles (2030).



2028

Euro 7 limits on tire abrasion take effect: passenger vehicles (2028), light commercial vehicles (2030), heavier commercial vehicles (2032).
