

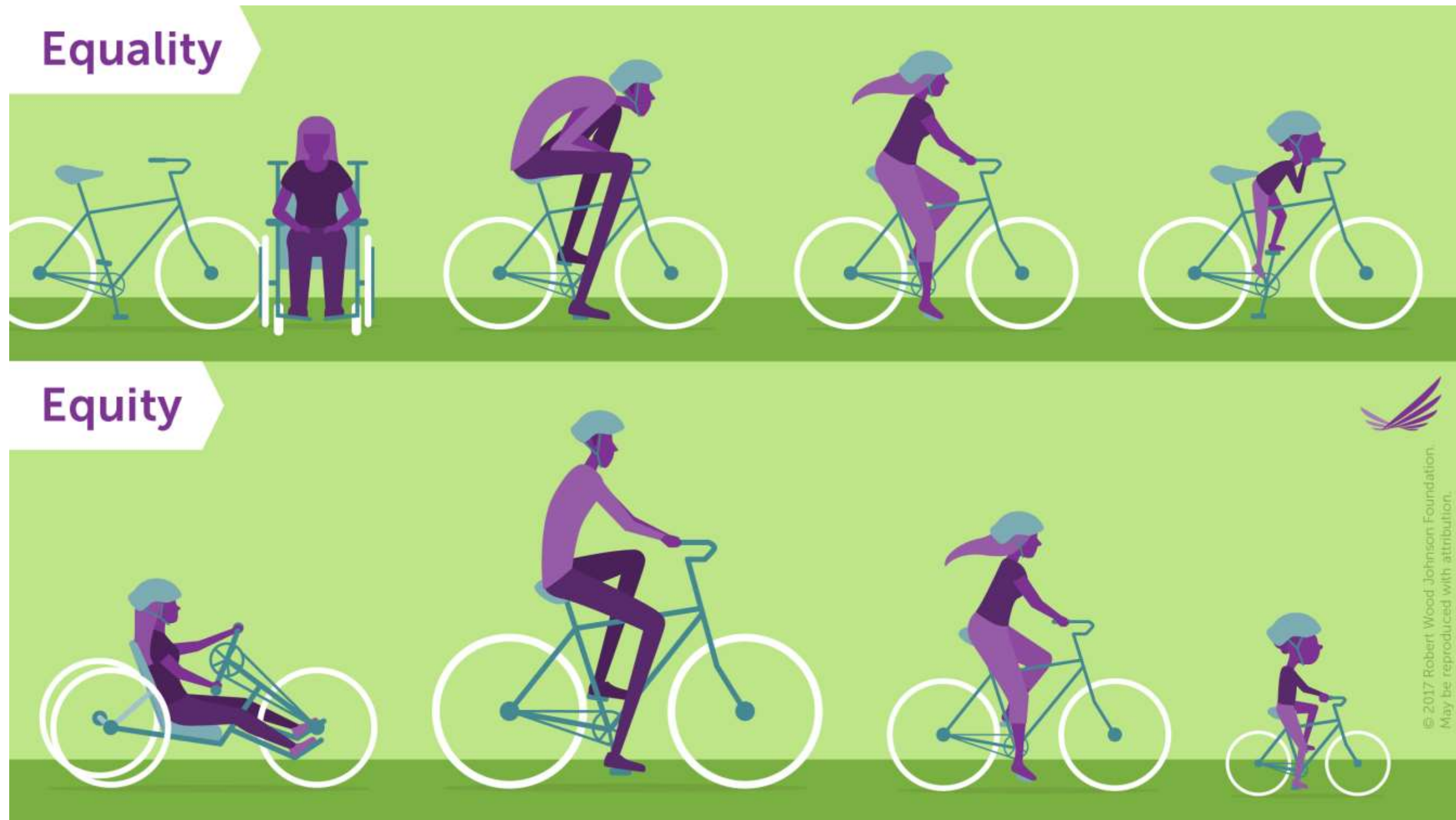

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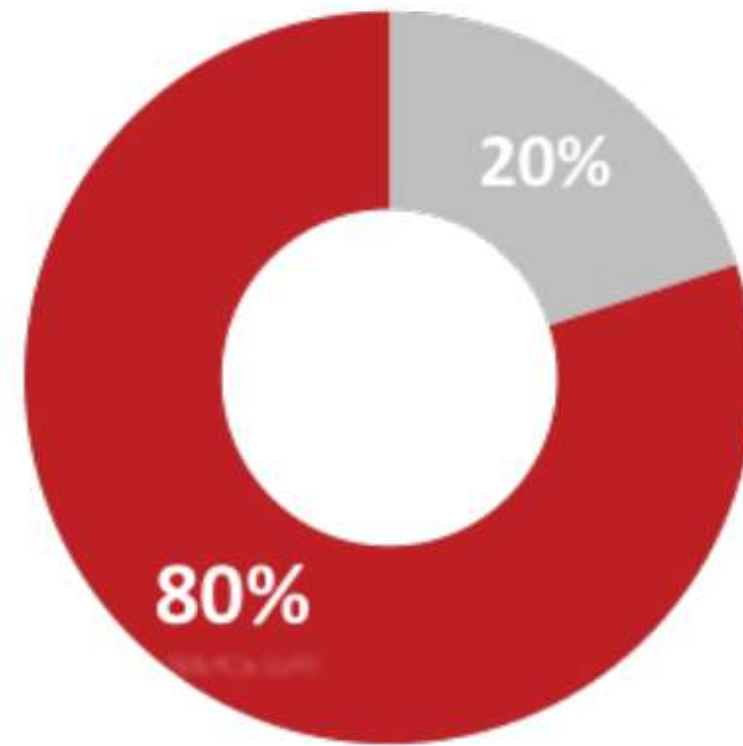

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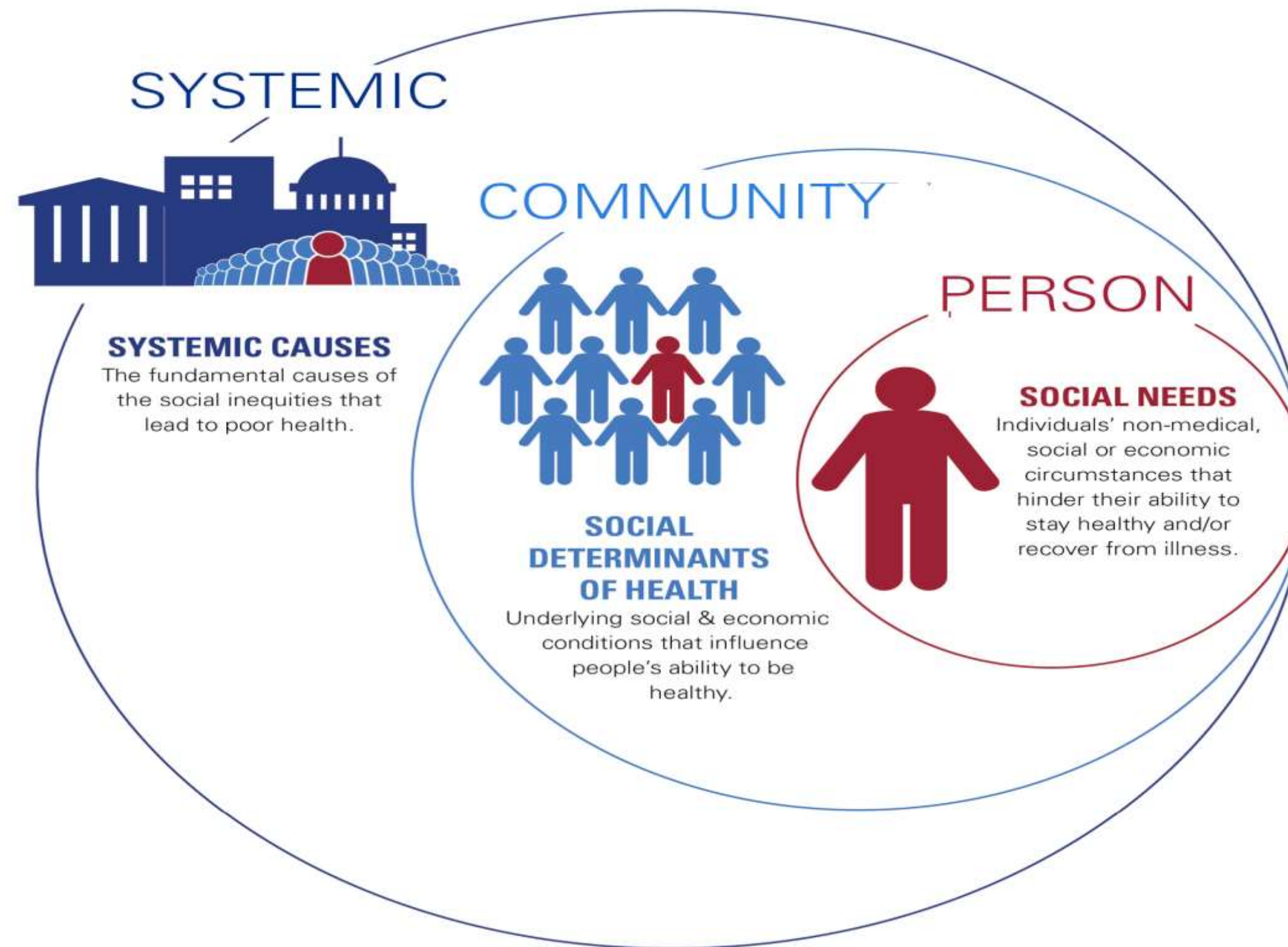

- Structural racism acts as a force in the distribution of opportunities to health

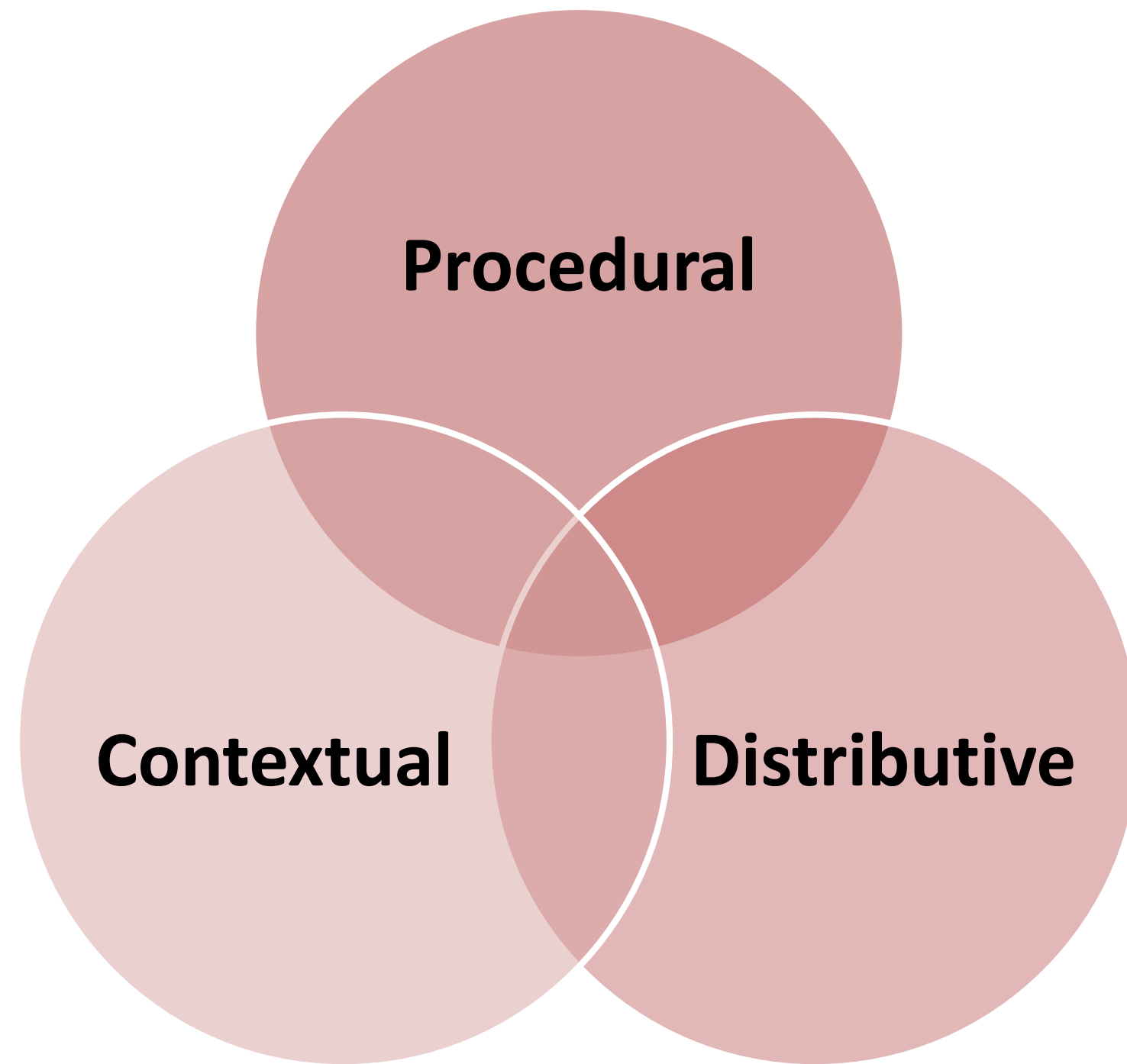
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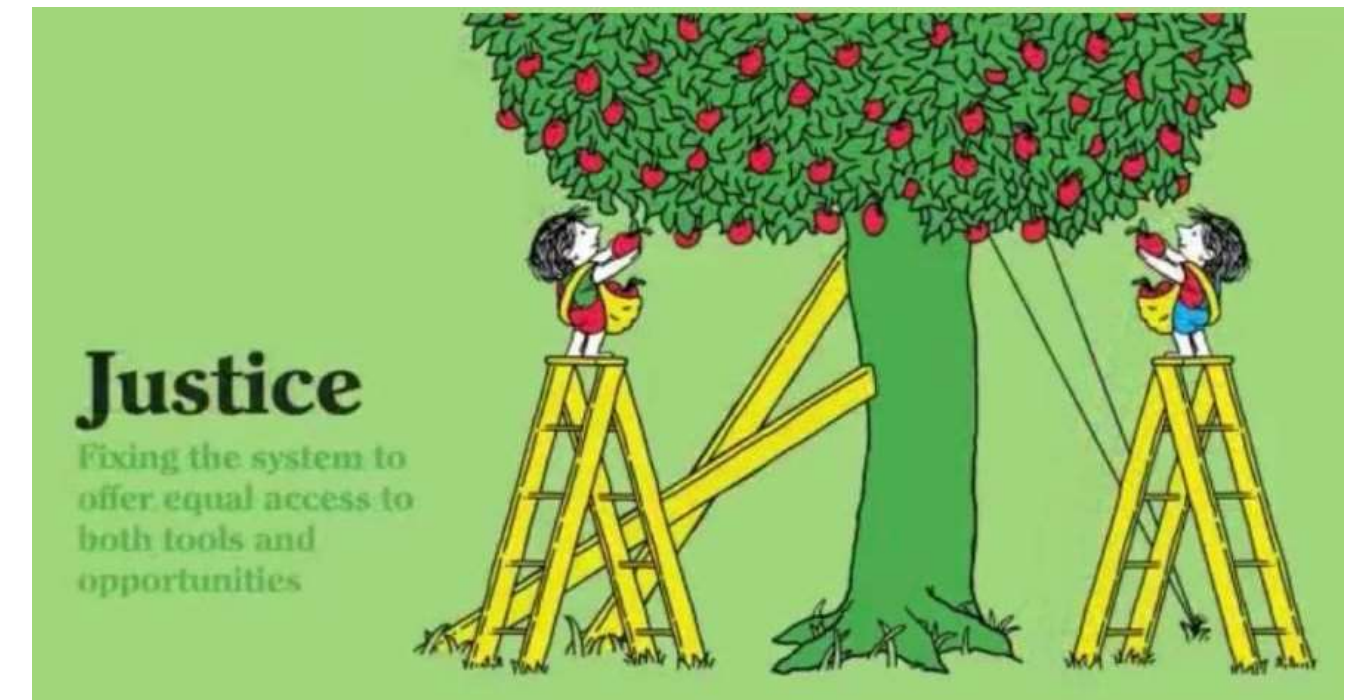
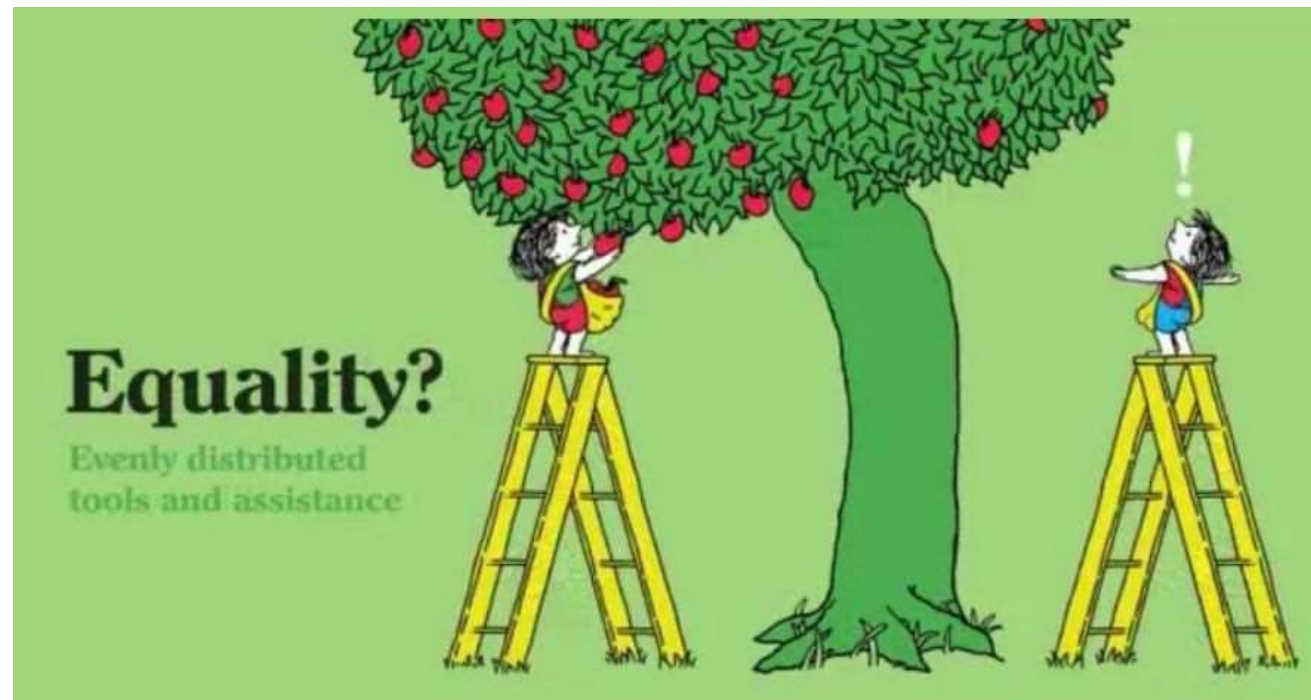
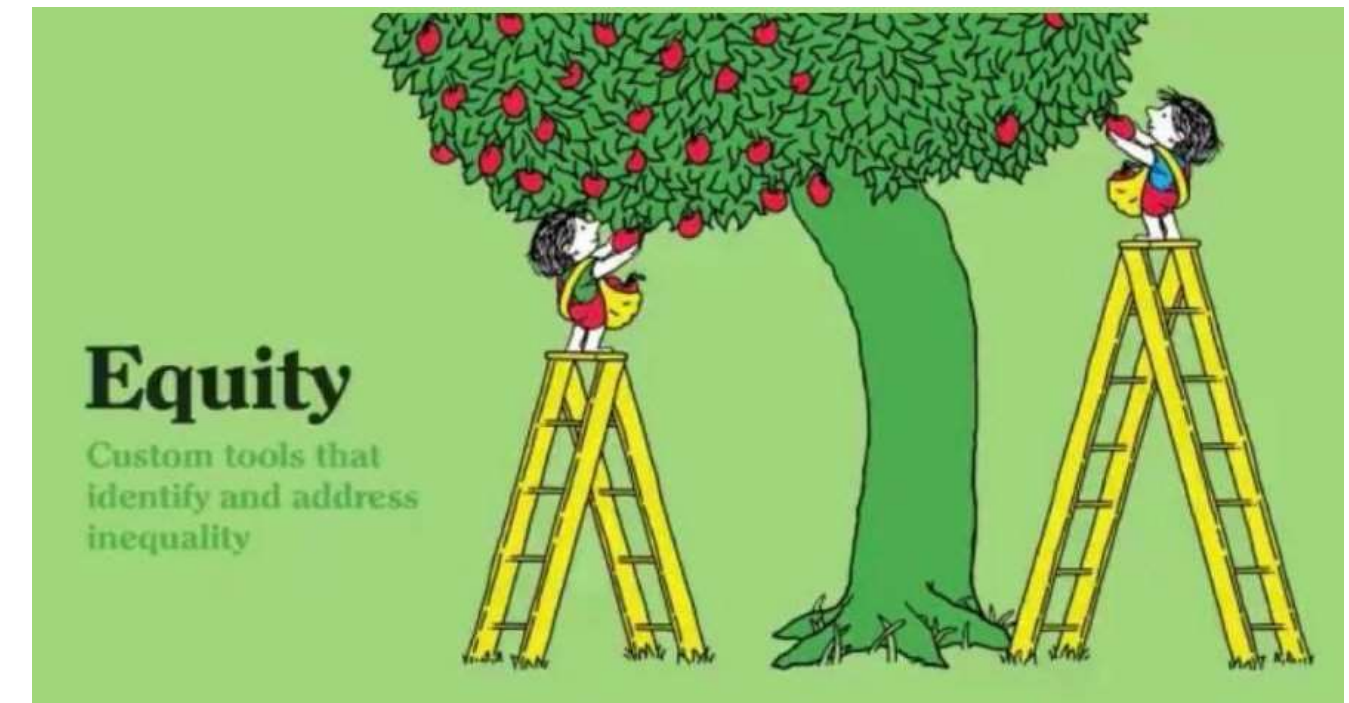
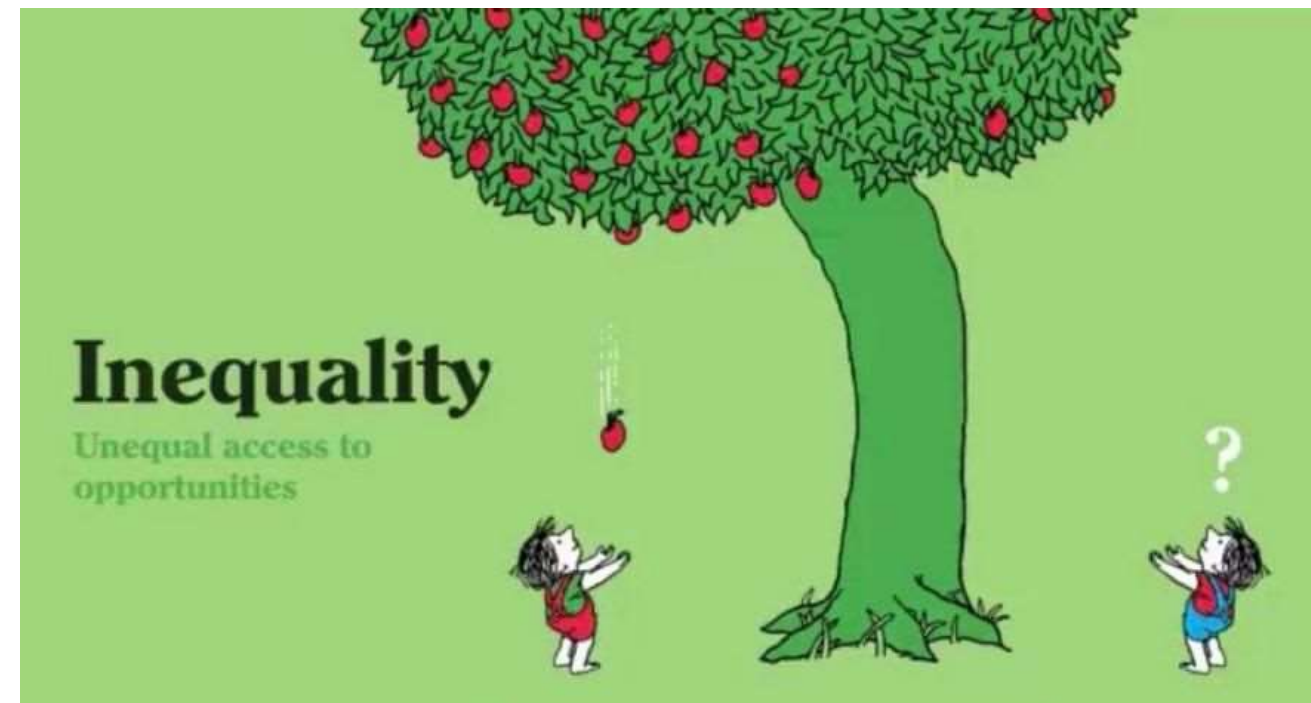
