






Fig. 2. A conceptual framework for the 'drivers of migration'.







#### What we know

- Environmental pressures come in many forms
- Environmental influences intertwine with economic, cultural, and other factors to shape migration (e.g. Honduras: Reichman 2022)
- In rural households, migration is only one among many adaptive livelihood strategies (West Africa: Teye and Nikoi 2022)
- In some areas, dry spells and regions yield higher outmigration (Bangaldesh: Carrico and Donato 2019)
- But less "natural capital" can bring also more outmigration
- Much environmentally-induced migration is internal (e.g., Ecuador: Clark and Bilsborrow 2013
- Social capital important (e.g., Bangladesh: Carrico and Donato 2019






### **Social Data Needs**

- Other livelihood options
- Qualitative insight



# Environmental data needs\_

- Accessible measures with flexible scaling
  - Spatial & temporal
- Important thresholds for drivers & impacts
  - mechanisms
  - crops; ecological services; health
- Consideration of uncertainty
- Education






