Weapon of Mass Destruction (WMD)



- A WMD is defined by U.S. law as any weapon designed to cause death or serious bodily injury through the release, dissemination, or impact of:
 - Toxic or poisonous chemicals
 - A disease organism
 - An explosive or incendiary device
 - Release of radiation or radioactivity at a level dangerous to humans





Radiological Dispersal Device (RDD)



Any device that causes the purposeful dissemination of radioactive material without a nuclear detonation

- Material Form
 - Solid
 - Liquid
 - Gas
- Dispersal
 - Explosively
 - Air
 - Water
- Contamination
- Exposure









Radiological Exposure Device (RED)



Radioactive material that may be hidden from sight with the intention of exposing people to radiation without their knowledge



Tihange Nuclear Power Plant Brussels, Belgium



Terrorist group conducted surveillance on Senior Nuclear Industry Official with access and information

- 10 hours of video surveillance of Plant Employee









- Planned to make a dirty bomb and disburse it over a populated area
- -Tried to recruit insiders from the plant
- Police raids in Brussels disrupted this plot







Airport and Metro Station Bombings Brussels, Belgium



"They rushed their operations because they were under pressure."

"The magnitude could have been much bigger if the terrorists had been able to implement their original plan and not opted for easier targets."

32 people killed 270+ injured

- Born October 18, 1970 in Brooklyn, New York, USA
- Latin Kings Gang Member
- Numerous arrests
- Plotted Dirty Bomb Attack in U.S.
- At 14 years old he was convicted of manslaughter
- Radicalized in Prison
- Training in Afghanistan and Pakistan
