














Education Working Group

Today institutions are failing to educate youth in solving the crises they face and in preparing them to lead through those challenges.

The Problem



The world is facing a learning crisis. While countries have significantly increased access to education, being in school isn't the same things as learning....
[T]he productivity of 56% of the world's children will be less than half of what it could be if they enjoyed complete education.



H200 Theory of Change

Short Term Impact: Youth have a career path oriented toward solution not problem nor merely awareness.




Mid Term Impact: Generation of empathetic leaders in public & private sectors and social entrepreneurs.



Long Term Impact: a healthier, safer world for every generation



- Access to the H2OO Youth Network including youth connection and opportunities shared by H2OO.


