Chartered by Congress in 1863 under the Lincoln Administration

Nonprofit, independent (i.e., not part of the federal government)

Not an advocacy organization

Ocean Studies Board Mission

Advise the federal government on issues of ocean science, engineering, and policy

Exercise leadership within the ocean community

Undertake studies at the request of federal agencies, Congress, other sponsors, or upon its own initiative

Explore the science, policies, and infrastructure needed to understand and protect coastal and marine environments and resources

UN General Assembly Proclamation

Dec. 6, 2017

Omnibus Resolution for Oceans and the Law of the Sea (A/RES/72/73)

- Proclaimed the **UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development 2021-2030**
- Called upon the IOC to prepare an **implementation plan** for the Decade
