

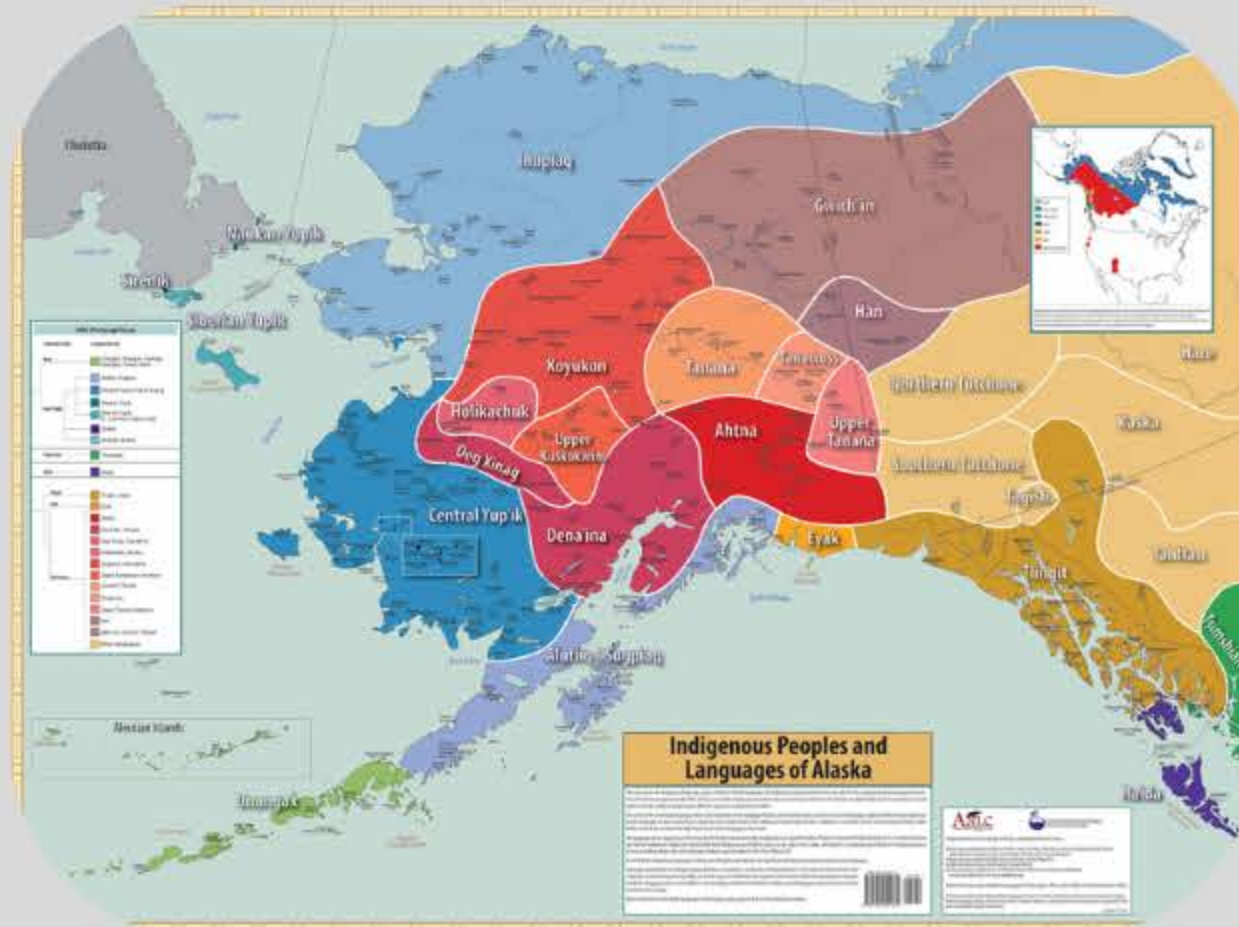
Tamamta (All of Us)
