

Role of organization

- JPA
- 22 member agencies, 6 associate agencies
 - 9 have agreements with Reclamation (CVP water service, settlement, Warren Act, Fazio)
- Actively engaged on matters related to water supplies, climate resilience, regulatory matters, ecosystem health, and policyrelated issues

Injecting the best science into operations

- Utilize science gathered to learn, modify, and adapt
- Use local regional resources
 - Examples: SMUD, PCWA forecasts; Water Forum fisheries and water quality data and synthesis
- Consider community concerns and impacts
- Recognize there are trade-offs that yield quantifiable and meaningful outcomes
