

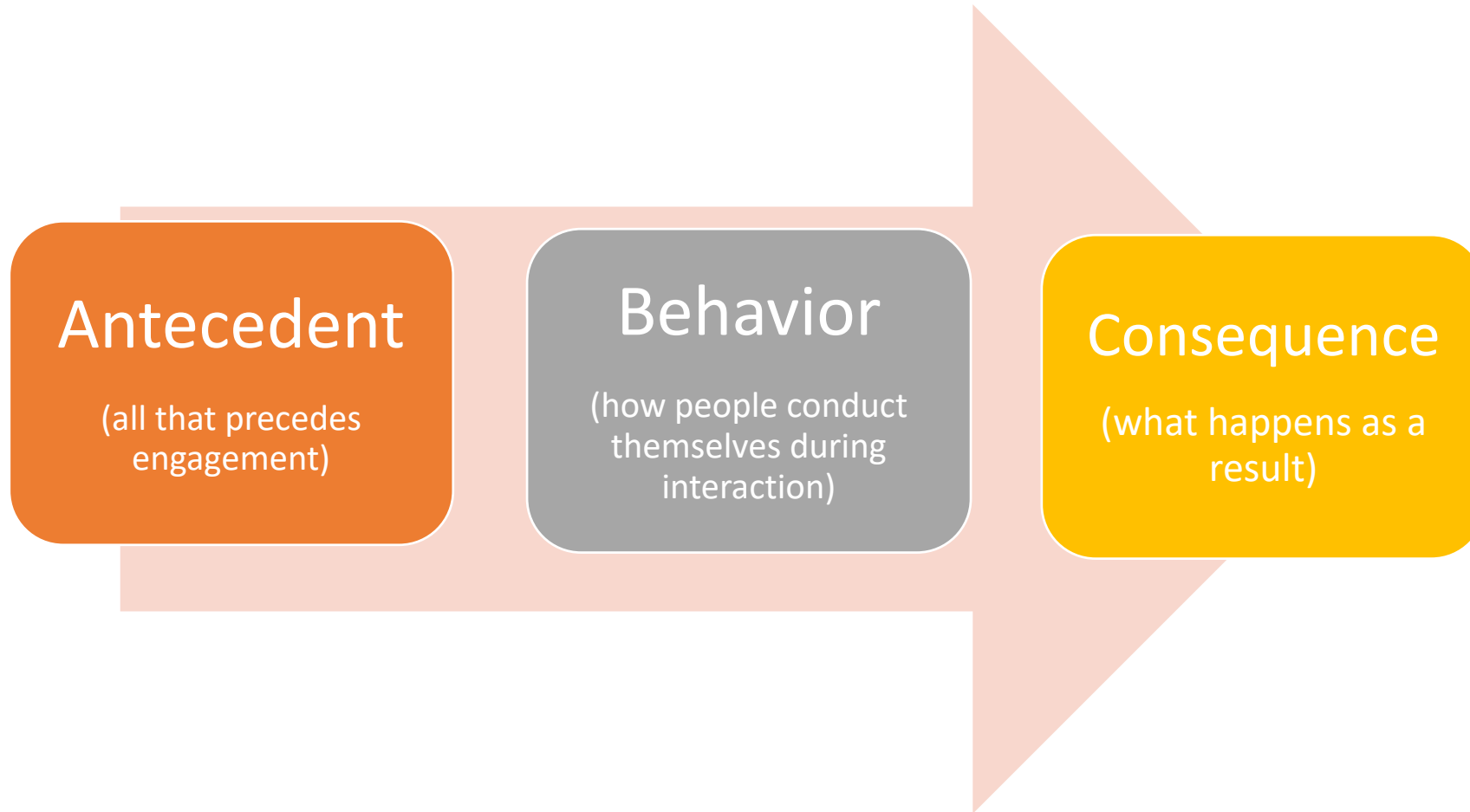

Communicating Technical Information



10^{-7} safe = 0.000001 = 0.0001% chance of an accident occurring OR
“It’s really safe”

Best Practices- Antecedent

Integrated planning, Transparency, Information, Inclusion

Make an Integrated Company Plan

Sell the organization on value of engagement early

Incorporate engagement specialists (communication, social scientists, etc) into the team

Be real about expectations

Secure Needed Resources

Get and secure the budget for what you need and who you need to hire to do this work

Need an internal champion at the highest level who is empowered to support the work

Plan Stakeholder Engagement Strategy

Create a comprehensive stakeholder plan that is traceable

Identify stakeholders and be as inclusive as possible

Build a plan to engage them early and give them real access

Best Practices- Behavior

Civil, Curious, Collaboration

Interaction

- Engage stakeholders meaningfully as early in the process as possible.
- Create interactions that maximize an opportunity to build relationships, conversations, and trust
- Include leadership in discussions
- Create work plans that include stakeholders

Communication

- Conduct two-way engagement
- Plain English communication
- Provide channels for feedback and evaluation
- Meeting summary
- Listen deeply
