

- Tools to help:
 - Calculate and publicize going rate for storage (per gig per year?)
 - Clarification of rules (e.g. still pending changes to Common Rule)
 - ELSI research, clear policies, a la Google lawsuit
- Methods to encourage:
 - Require as part of grant/budget
 - Stick: no data, no indexed publication
 - Carrot: recognition of best practices
- Challenges:
 - Risk of breach-financial, NYX headline
