Take-Aways from the Health Professions Forum

- Learning is about making relationships, building connections
- As faculty we are a knowledge network – create multiple learning pathways
- Don't lock in knowledge – this would be a fundamental change in how we teach in health professions
- Mixing old-school teaching with the newest technology is not as effective as you want it to be!
- Develop tasks of learning to provide optimal challenge, relevant to personal interests, just enough challenge but not out of reach.

Take-Aways (continued)

- Technology has to be married with good pedagogy on how students learning
- Learner-centered approach – enable students to take responsibility in learning
- Interactive video transforms a passive experience into an active learning experience
- 1.3 Billion users of the You-Tube – give learners choices!
- Need to provide digital wisdom to those who need it
