





The purpose of a group or team approach is to optimize the special contribution in skills and knowledge of the team members so that the needs of the persons served can be met more efficiently effectively, competently, and more considerately than would be possible by independent and individual action. Without question, the patient himself is a member of the team and, in a democratic society, can be expected increasingly to exert his prerogatives to participate in decisions that affect his well-being.

A major deterrent to our efforts to fashion health care that is efficient, effective, comprehensive, and personalized is our lack of a design for the synergistic interrelationship of all who can contribute to the patient's well-being. We face, in the next decade, a national challenge to redeploy the functions of health professions in new ways, extending the roles of some, perhaps eliminating others, but more closely meshing the functions




he job market is not looking bright for Americans of all walks of life, even Ivy League college graduates and those with advanced degrees. For example, a new wave of law school graduates has just taken state bar examinations, which they must pass to

obtain a license to practice law. But after accumulating as much as \$150,000 in law school debt (likely on top of undergraduate debt), many of those testtakers are concerned that jobs in their field are vanishing.

Health care system is changing rapidly: Regulation needs to adapt

- New care delivery and payment models encourage new roles among existing health providers
- At same time, new roles are emerging –community health workers, care coordinators, community paramedics, etc.
- Technology and scientific advancements are changing roles and responsibilities



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
