

Broad Points

- Many people live with multiple infection-associated conditions and want to understand the interconnections
- Urgent need to break down siloes
- Urgent need to find ways to overcome time lag of 17 years to translate research—prioritizing how research can lead to timely reforms to medical education.
- Imperative to include Lyme disease and tickborne coinfections— patients I
 interviewed are worried about being left behind due to the ongoing controversy
 around Lyme disease, which has slowed research.
