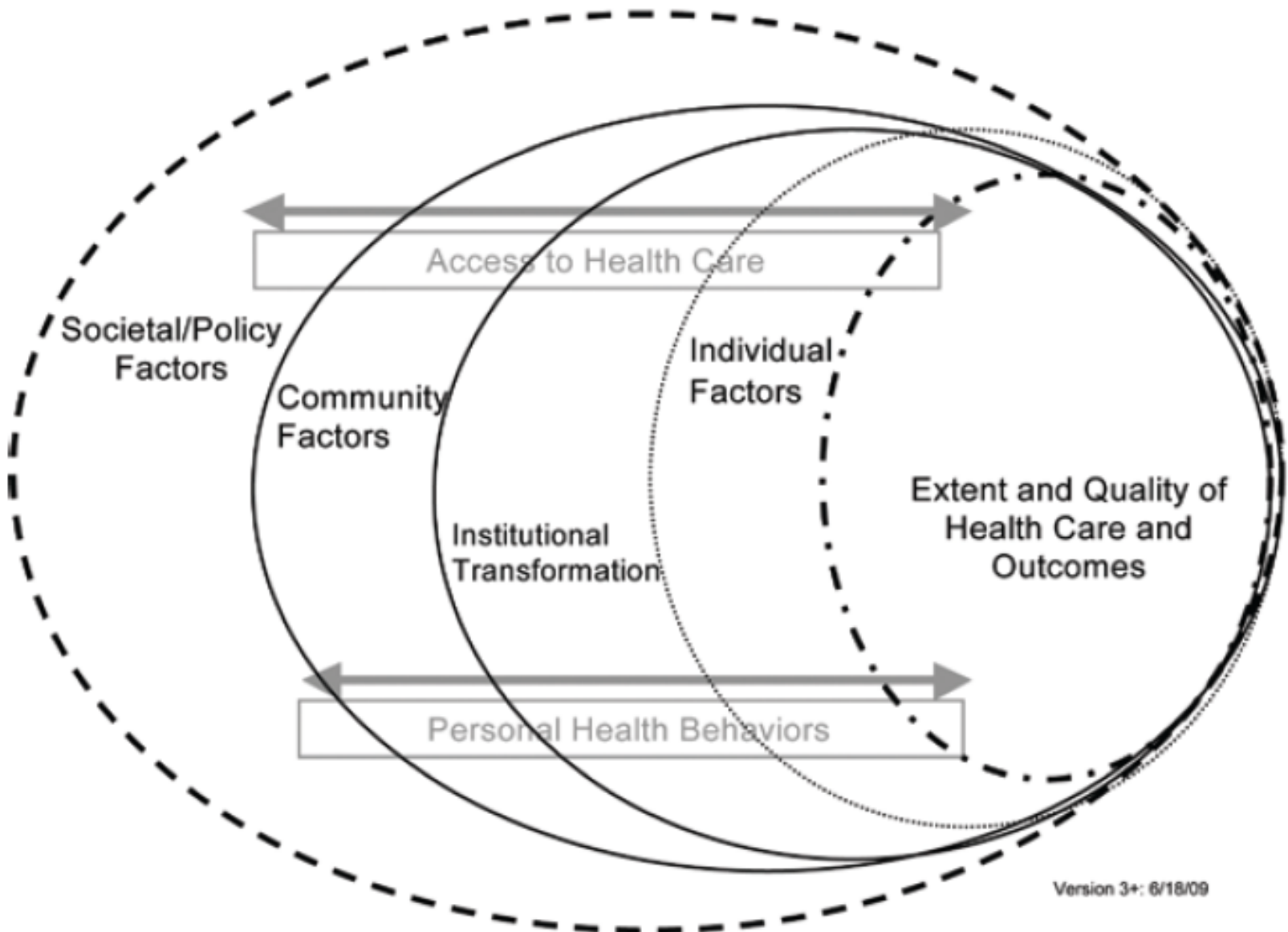

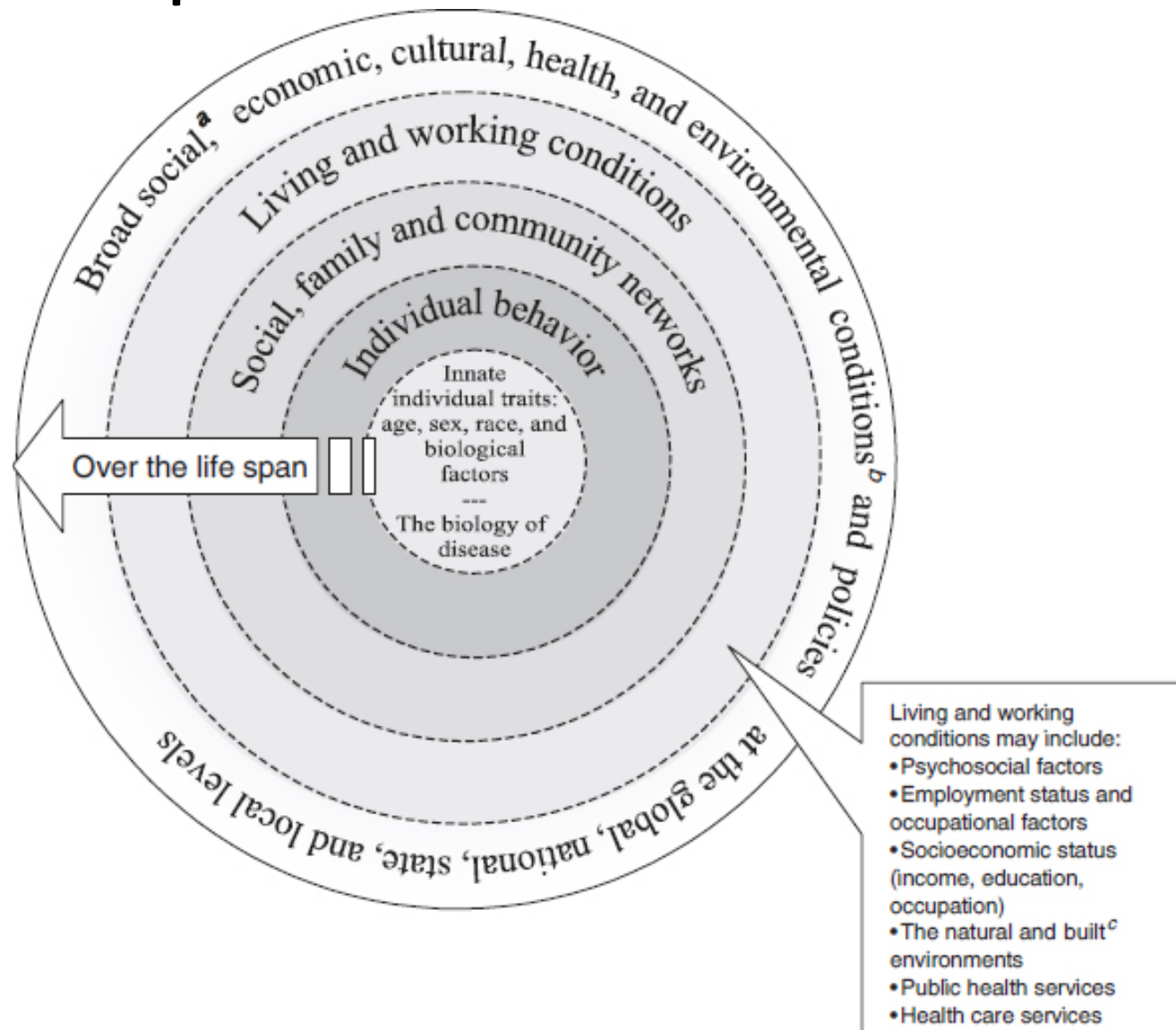
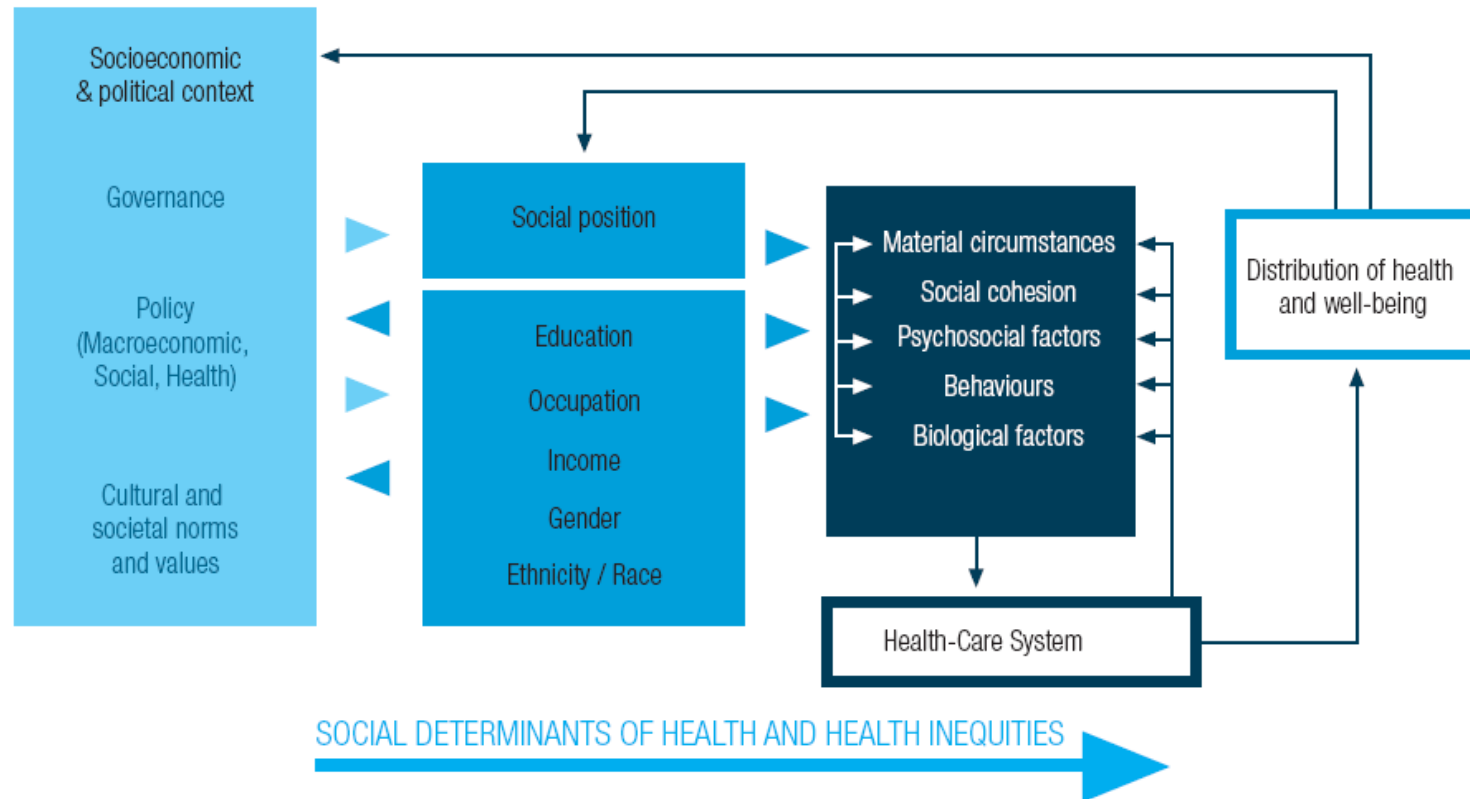
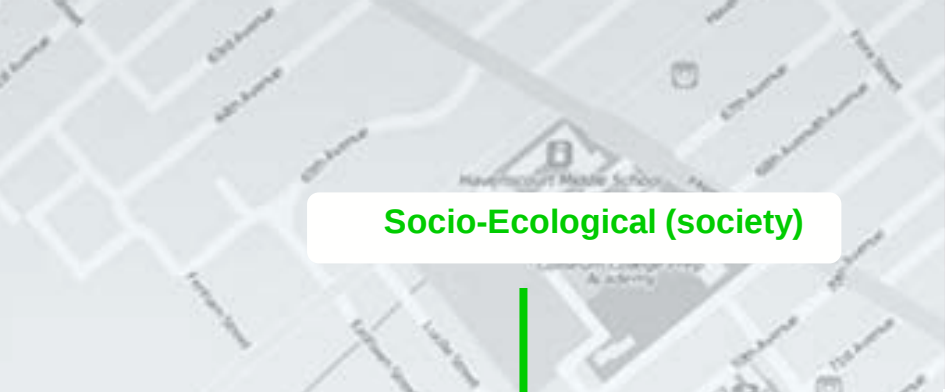


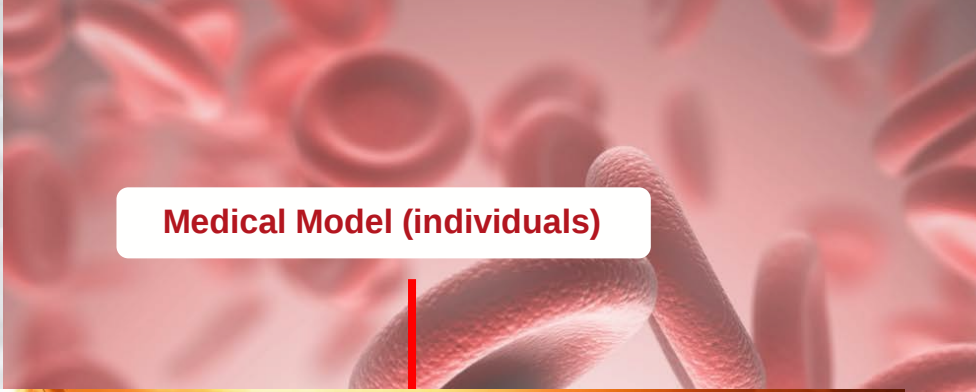
Figure 4.1 Commission on Social Determinants of Health conceptual framework.
