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



## New standards and requirements

- Injury and Illness Prevention Program
  - Aerosol Transmissible Disease standard
- Aerosol Generating Procedures
  - Engineering controls
  - Work practice controls
  - Personal Protective Equipment
- Cleaning and disinfection












## **Prioritizing Clinical Care**

- Previously deferred treatment
- Previously scheduled urgent procedures
- Patients who are likely to develop dental emergencies
- Preventive services (fluoride, sealants, scaling)
- Non-aerosol generating dental procedures
  - If aerosol generating procedures are necessary, employ aerosol management tools and use transmission based precautions



### **COVID 19 Dental Guidance: Lessons Learned**

- Communicate the role of various agencies in ensuring a safe environment
- Engage the dental community early in the process
- Understand and address unique barriers and challenges
- Use images and graphics to support text heavy guidance documents
