NIH Reporting on Medical Research

- In 2006: Congress mandated that NIH develop a comprehensive and transparent public reporting system
 - At that time, each NIH Institute/Center employed its own system to report medical research funding
- FY 2008: NIH implemented Research, Condition, Disease Categorization (RCDC)
 - Improved consistency and transparency
 - Official NIH spending figures
 - Computerized reporting process
- FY 2019: 292 publicly reported categories

FY 2019 Autoimmune Disease RCDC Category


- Autoimmune disease "parent" category total \$988M
 - Includes "children" subcategories that are individual autoimmune diseases of Congressional/NIH/public interest
 - Inflammatory bowel disease \$163M
 Includes Crohn's disease (a child of IBD) \$76M
 - Lupus \$121M
 - Multiple sclerosis \$111M
 - Rheumatoid arthritis \$94M
 - Scleroderma \$24M
 - Psoriasis \$16M
 - Myasthenia gravis \$5M
 - All other autoimmune disease research at NIH

RCDC Caveats to Consider


RCDC does not prorate research in grants and contracts

Many well-know autoimmune diseases do not have their own child RCDC category, e.g., Type 1 diabetes, Sjögren's syndrome, Celiac disease

FY 2019 Mechanisms and Funding

- \$988M: Intramural = \$137M (14%) and Extramural = \$851M (86%)

Extramural Research: Solicited vs Unsolicited

- Solicited research
 - NIH drives some research activities to address scientific gaps or specific needs, for example clinical trial networks
 - Collaborative process to develop trans-NIH solicited research
- Unsolicited research
 - Investigator-initiated research where the science drives the research
