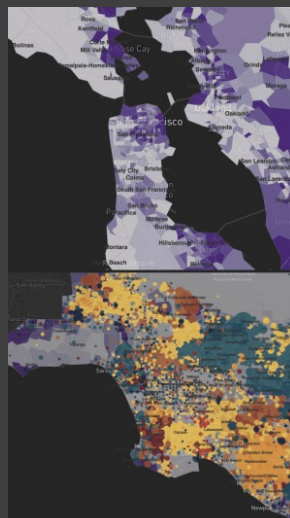

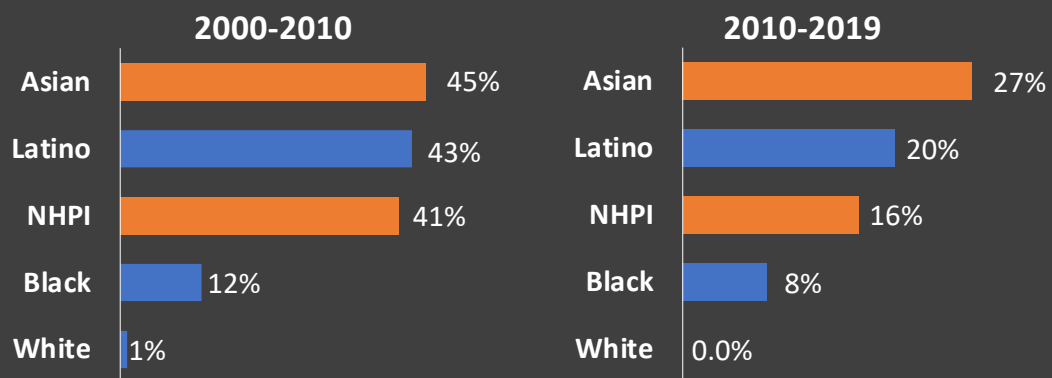

Legal History of AAPI Exclusion

- 1790 - Naturalization Act
- 1862 - Anti-Coolie Act (California)
- 1875 - Page Act
- 1879 - California Constitution revision (Article 19)
- 1882 - Chinese Exclusion Act
- 1893 - Overthrow of Hawaiian kingdom
- 1907 - Gentleman's Agreement (Japan)
- 1910 - Angel Island immigration detention center
- 1913 - Alien Land Law (CA, more states later)
- 1917 - Asiatic Barred Zone
- 1935 - Filipino Repatriation Act
- 1942 - Exec Order 9066 (Japanese Am internment)
- 1946 - Nuclear weapon detonations in Pacific islands

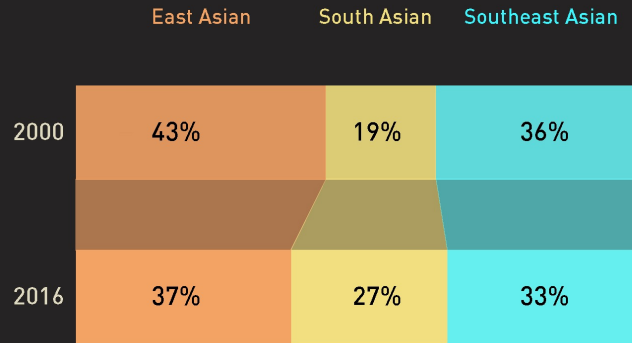

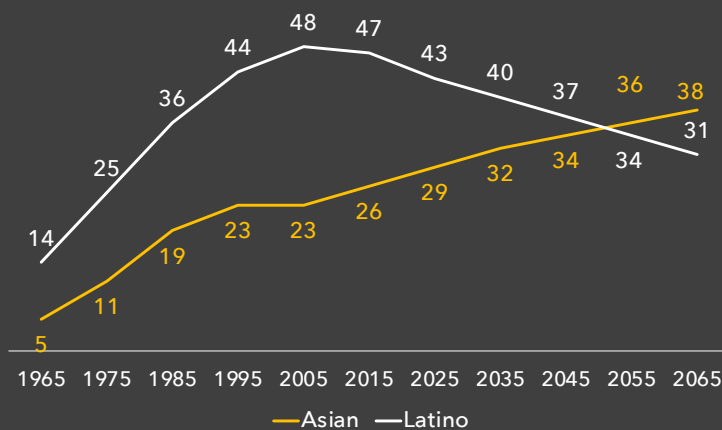

Growing Share of Foreign Born

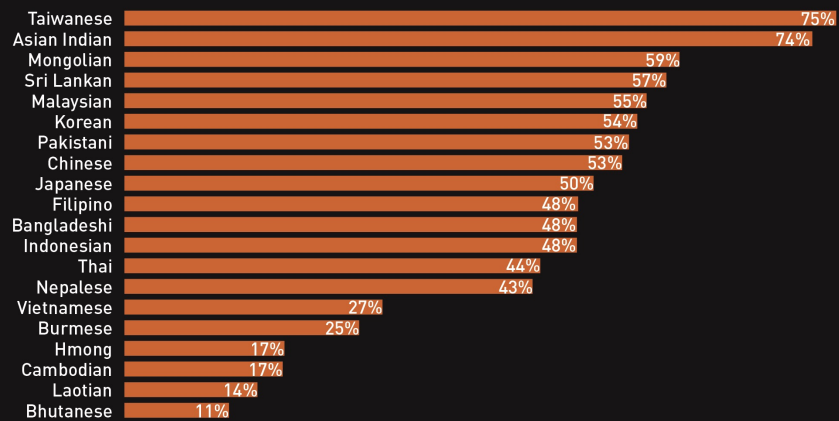

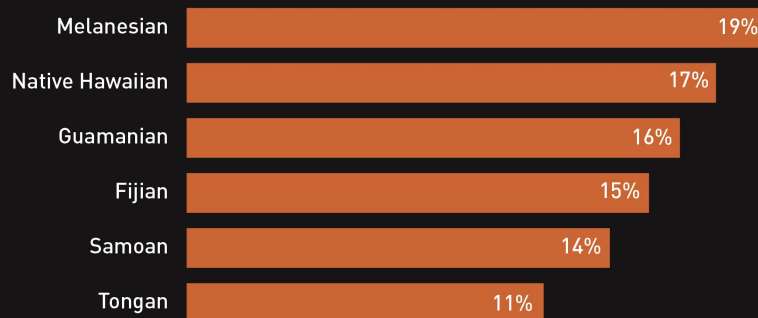
Bachelor's Degree or Higher (Asian Am)

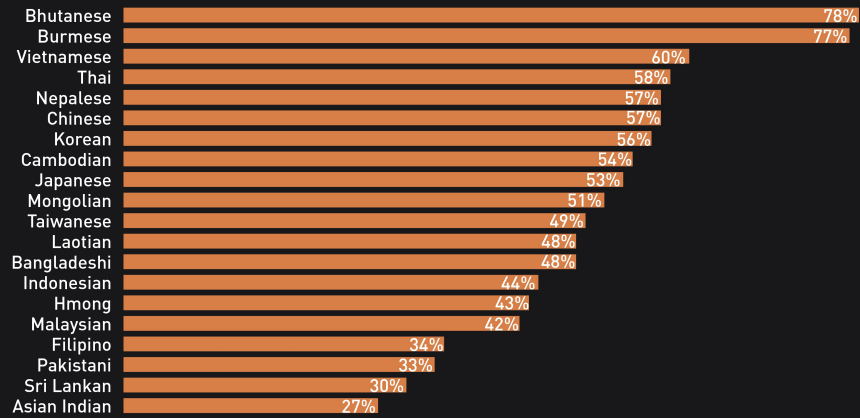

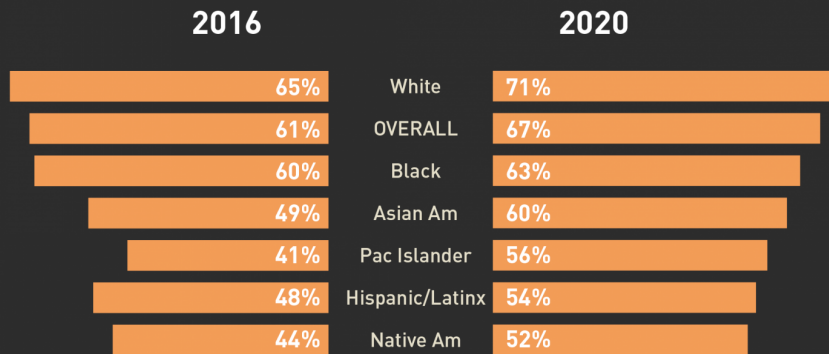

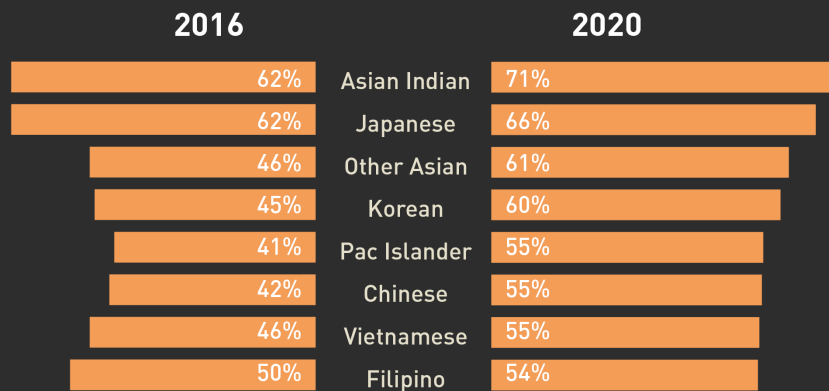
Voting By Race, Presidential Elections

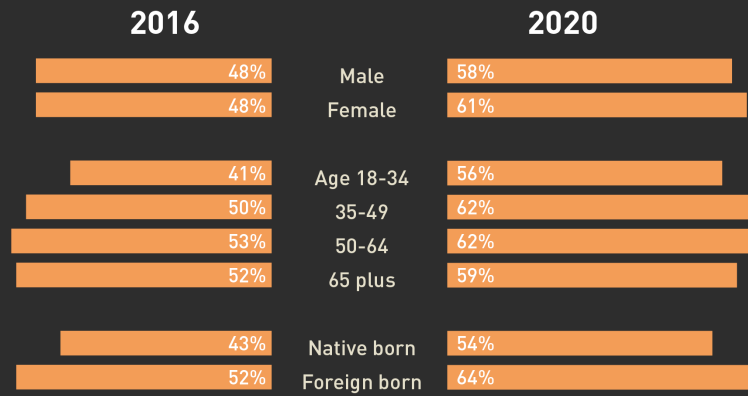
AAPI Voting in Presidential Elections

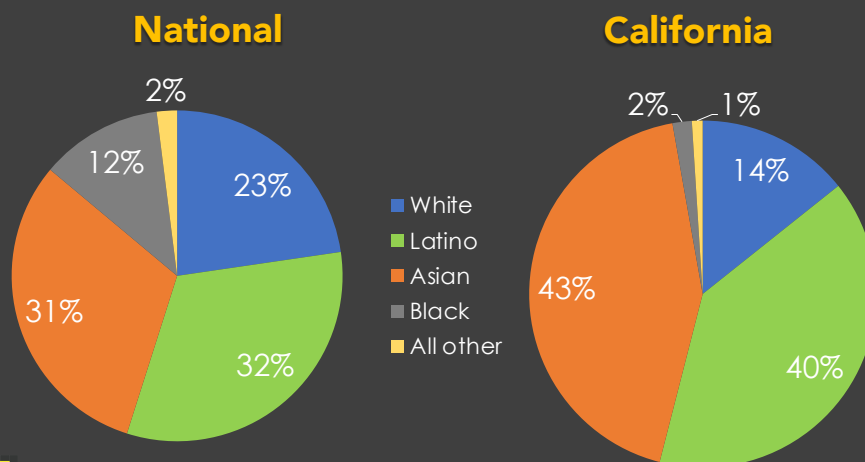

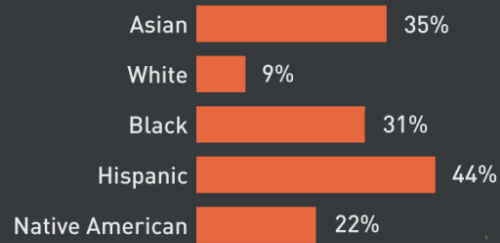

Health and Civil Rights Impacts

Because of COVID-19 in the United States, 13,620 more Asian Americans died than usual. This represents a 35% increase over the prior 5-year average.

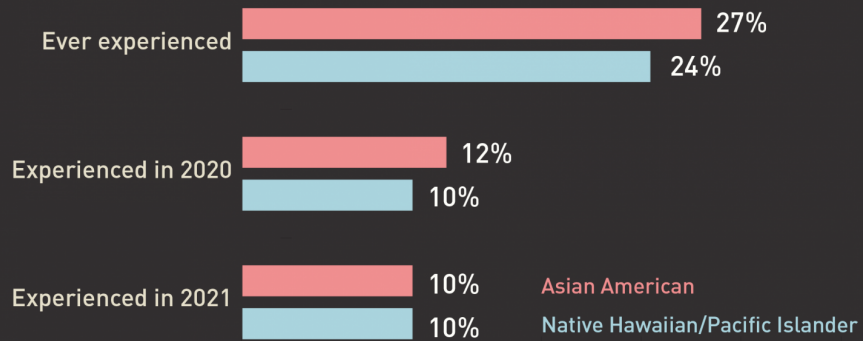

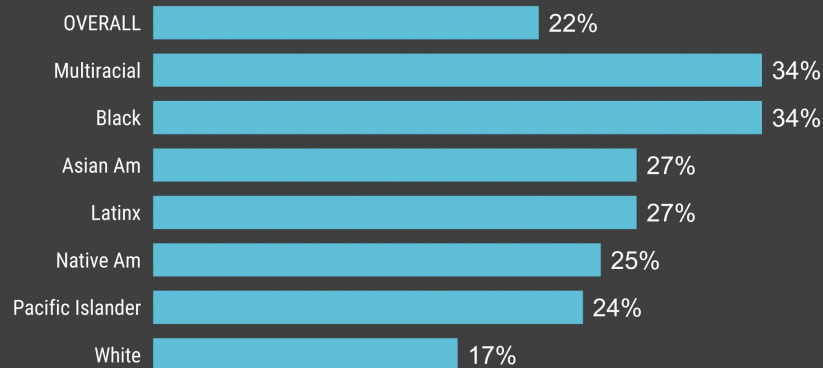

Have you ever been a victim of a hate crime? That is, have you ever had someone verbally or physically abuse you, or damage your property specifically because of your race or ethnicity?

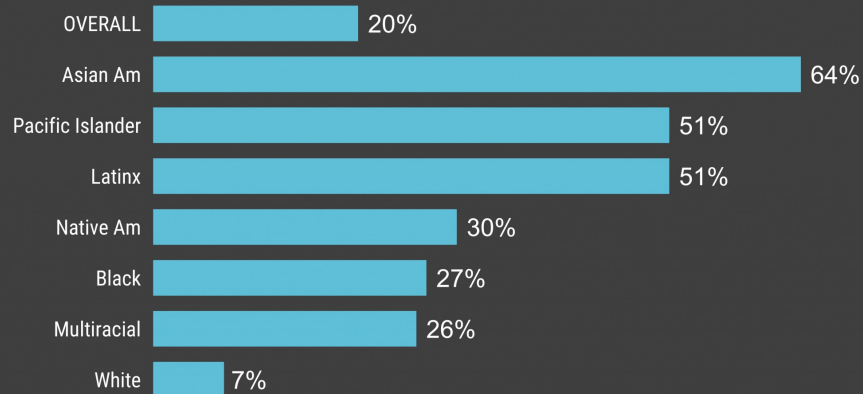

Have people asked where you from, assuming you're not from the U.S.?

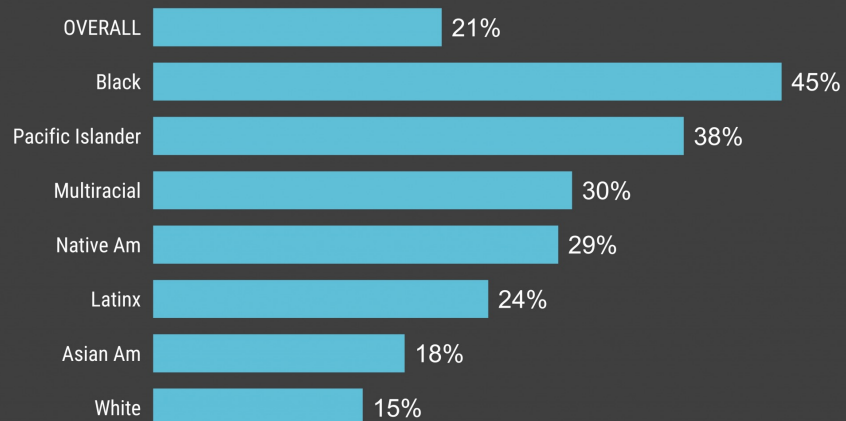

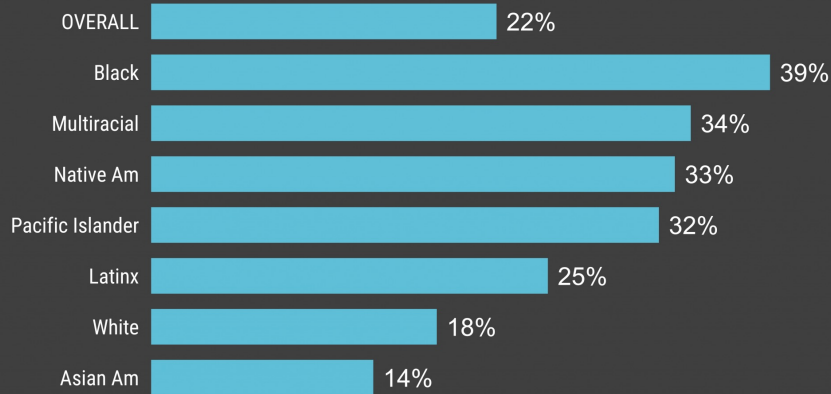

Have you ever been unfairly stopped, searched, questioned, physically threatened or abused by the police?

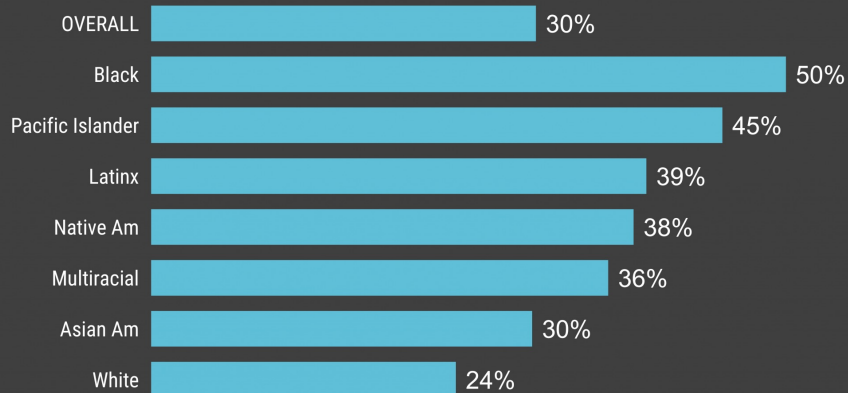

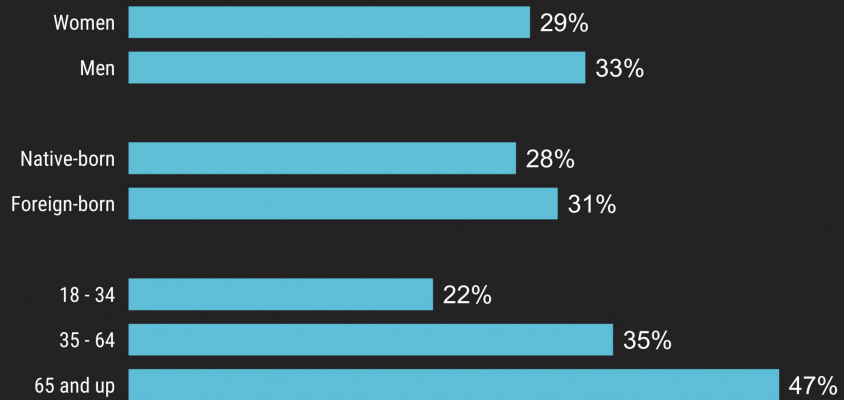
