THE MAGNITUDE OF THE PROBLEM IS UNDERAPPRECIATED

Despite many successful initiatives and efforts by government and philanthropy, investments in support of health equity are outpaced by the actions of many, many other interests.

As one example, advertising alone for sweetened beverages exceeds \$1 Billion/year.

The sweetened beverage industry isn't seeking to contribute to health inequities, but they won't stop producing their products as long as they are making a profit.






Shaping Ideology

HEALTH EQUITY WILL BE IMPROVED ONLY IF POWER EXERCISED RESULTS IN COMMUNITY CHANGE








METRICS FOR HEALTH EQUITY

"Community power is not a singular thing, attribute, or condition – it is a term representing a dynamic, relational quality within communities."

Eric Olin Wright's work is a relevant model to consider for metrics of communities. Wright emphasized the relative nature of poverty, and that absolute dollar amounts as an 'index of poverty' missed the *meaning* associated with differentials in income levels that translated into marginalization, ostracism, and diminished voice within the broader community.
