Women's Health Access Matters

NASEM: Assessment of NIH Research on Women's Health

Committee charge:

...analyze "the proportion of research that the NIH funds on conditions that are femalespecific and/or more common amongst women or that differently impact women"

and

"determine the appropriate level of funding that is needed to address gaps in women's health research at NIH."



NASEM Committee Recommendations

- Research priorities for NIHsupported research on women's health.
- NIH training and education efforts to build, support, and maintain a robust women's health research workforce.
- NIH structure (extra- and intramural), systems, and review processes to optimize women's health research

- NIH-wide workforce to effectively solicit, review, and support women's health research
- Defining women's health in today's social and cultural climate
- Allocation of funding needed to address gaps in women's health research at NIH.

Committee charge:

Recommendations

#3not30 Goals

- 1. Double the budget!
 - Prioritize from basic science to social science
 - Therapeutic areas and cross-cutting questions

Many opportunities for high impact investment given evidence gaps

- 2. Increase access and reach of clinical trials
 - Research in and with communities
 - Valuing lived experience

 - Secondary analyses
 - WHAM Accountability Index
