

Updates from the DRI for Energy Committee

- Three working groups formed to more efficiently accomplish the SOW
- Information Gathering Open Forum held on 2/4/22
- Consultants identified to carry out analysis of available DLW data
- Data requests for IAEA, HCHS/SOL, and the Harvard Men's Lifestyle Validation Study DLW databases will be submitted by the consultant
- Added two additional committee members-Drs. Bill Wong and Scott Crouter
- Scoping of systematic reviews to inform the committee's work has begun

Challenges of the DRI for Energy Committee

- Definition of “Healthy” and using BMI as the indicator
- Lack of systematic reviews to guide the work of the committee
- Inclusion of other DLW data bases to increase generalizability of the new equations
 - Within the IAEA data base-which DLW studies to include and exclude
- Applying the SOW to the Risk Assessment Framework
- How much should the committee focus on public health implications/application?
