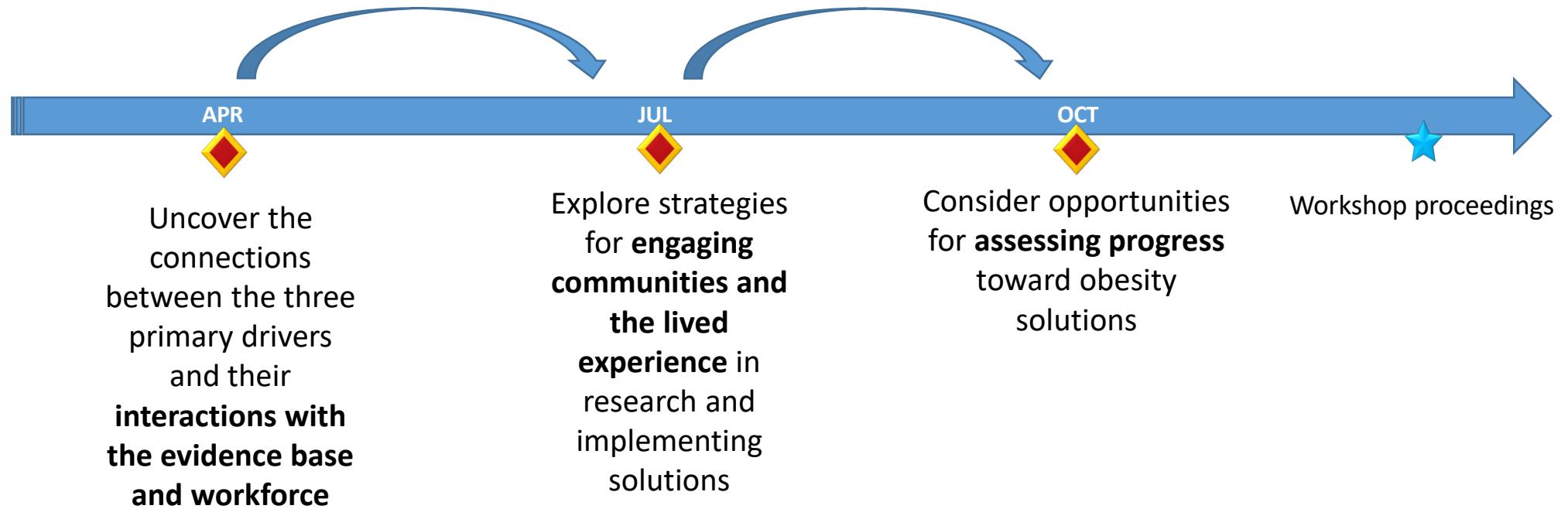
2021 ROUNDTABLE WORKSHOP SERIES
