
### Cancer risk from environmental exposures


## Learning a little about a lot of people with satellite imagery


- Satellite imagery has been around since 1940
- Revolution in how to process this type of data
- Opportunity for health disparities and cancer:
  - Ubiquitous
  - Repetitive in time
  - Flexible in spatial scale
  - Often free or low cost
  - Reliability
- What can we learn?



### Imagery - San Diego

- San Diego Dataset comes from Digital Globe's Global Basemap.
- Imagery is a composite from 2012 from several satellite passes
- 0.5 meter imagery, RGB, ~418,000 tiles, 200x200 pixels
- Applied Convolutional Neural Net algorithm and then kmeans clustering on features














# Learning a lot about a few people with Global Positioning System data

#### Dynamic Assessment of Environment Exposure


