# Health Centers' 2020 COVID-19 Experience

The COVID-19 pandemic presented unique and unprecedented challenges for Health Centers in 2020. Health Center's reported the effects of the pandemic on health center staff and operations.



Health Center Staff Unable to Work 6.9% on average 14.4% at peak



Staff Testing Positive

1 in 8 in total




Sites Temporarily Closed1,110 on average2,073 at peak







# Health Center Clinical Transformation Journey: 2010 - Present

77% of health centers were recognized as patient-centered medical homes (PCMH) in 2020 from 12% in 2012






# 5-Year Trend in Cancer Screening Clinical Quality Measures (CQMs)

 The breast cancer screening CQM was added to UDS in 2020.


#### **Cancer Screening in Health Centers: 2016-2020**


