Medicare Opportunities and Challenges

- Behavioral Health Integration Codes
 - Also Interprofessional Consultation Codes
- Expanded Coverage of Telehealth
 - Need clear policy on continuation of coverage
- Opioid Treatment Program Benefit
 - Bundled payment expanded to treatment of other SUDs
- Initiation of Medication Assisted Treatment in Emergency Departments
 - In Physician Fee Schedule Rule



Medicaid Opportunities and Challenges

- Reimbursement for Behavioral Healthcare Consultation
 - Paying for services delivered outside the presence of the patient
 - Section 1115 authority Rhode Island
- Coverage of Case Management and Care Coordination
 - Targeted Case Management Benefit
 - Health Home Benefit



Overarching Issues

Implementation Costs

- Staffing, training, billing, and workflow changes
- Technology for consultation and remote services

Workforce Challenges

- Availability of Behavioral Healthcare Providers
- Participation in Insurance/Medicare/Medicaid
- Reluctance to Screen and Engage on MH/SUD
- Awareness of Opportunities and Coordination of Financing
 - Medicare/Medicaid/insurance and grant funding
