E. Left Mid Prostate: Needle Core Biopsy: Benign prostatic tissue

F. Left Base Prostate: Needle Core Biopsy: Benign prostatic tissue

G. Lesion #1 Prostate: Needle Core Biopsy: Prostatic adenocarcinoma
Gleason pattern: 4 + 5 = 9/10
Percent Gleason pattern 4: 60%

Percent of Gleason pattern 5: 40% Grade Group: 5

Number of cores involved: 2/3

Maximum involvement of a single core: 30% Overall involvement by carcinoma: 25% Extraprostatic extension: Not identified Perineural invasion: Not identified


