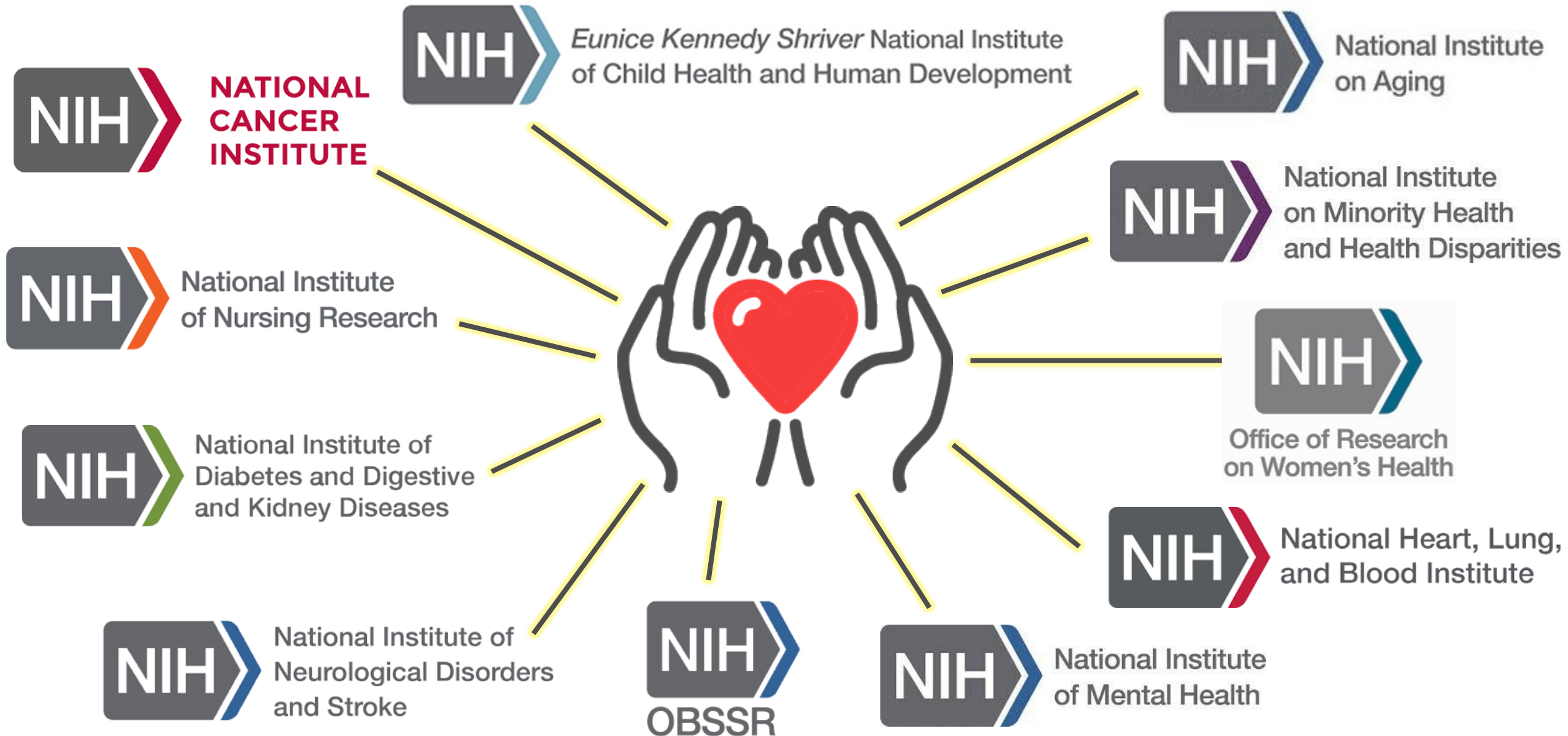

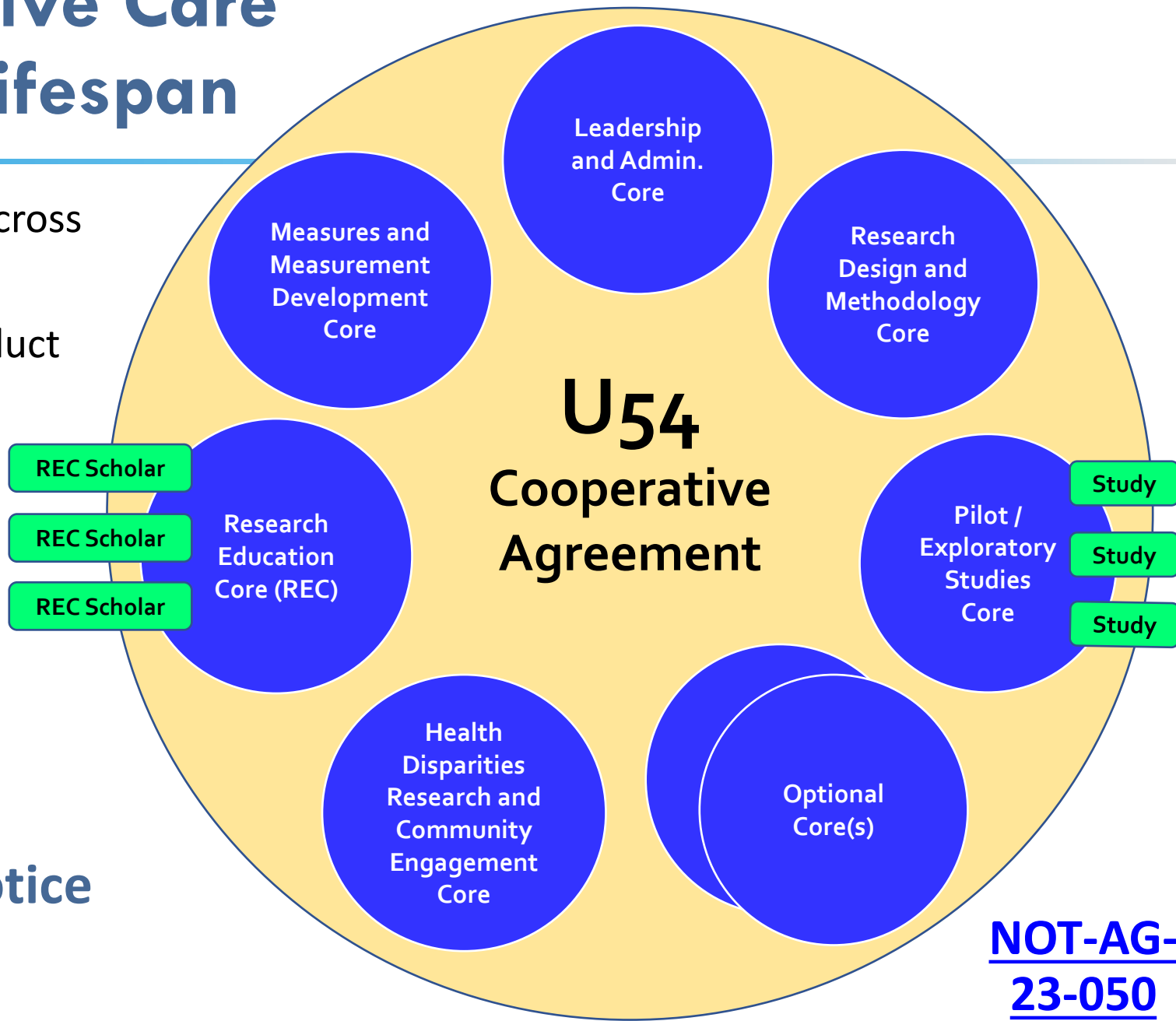

- **Pilot / Exploratory Core** will support studies informed by research priorities.
- Significant focus on building capacity, facilitating, and supporting research to understand and address **health and healthcare disparities** in palliative care
