
### The triple-aim concept

• 3 An accountable utilization of the financial, human and natural ressources

#### Need for a federal law on health

SAMS put in place in 2022 a think tank which accompanied a mandate to *unisanté* Lausanne (Prof. Stéfanie Monod) in order to define the **content of such a law** and the best way to achieve this goal

### In Summary

- The Swiss health system must be reformed and must include the concepts of sustainability and «One Health», and encompass the whole lifespan, (including aging, functioning and rehabilitation)
- The SAMS roadmap (2019) has paved the way for a federal law on health which will be further promoted in 2024
- New models of coordinated care based on interprofessionnality and interdisciplinarity must be put in place to improve the health of the population and the individuals according to the «triple aim»
- In these models, the GPs will have to coordinate interprofessional and multidisciplinary teams supported by new techniques (ML, IA) in close association with the patient – educated and empowered – in the center of the system
- These models will promote implementation of good clinical practices and fight against inappropriate overmedicalization (smarter medicine)
