The Issues (CDC, 2021)

- 50% of ALL lifetime mental illness begins by age 14
- 1 in 6 children ages 6 to 17 experiences a mental health disorder
- 1 in 5 seriously considered attempting suicide
- 1 in 10 made a suicide attempt
- Stressors Impacting Our Youth
 - Social Media Influences
 - Bullying & Violence
 - Societal Issues
 - Post-Pandemic Academic Delays
- Less than 20% of youth receive psychiatric treatment
 - Of those needing treatment 70% obtain in school setting
 - Only 42% of public schools offer mental health treatment



The Context

The Public School Setting

- 3,200 students from pre-K to 8th grade
- 38 students in Autism Programs
- 24 students in Behavioral Disabilities Program
- Psychiatric Diagnoses:
 - Severe Depression
 - Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
 - Autism Spectrum Disorder
 - Disruptive Mood Dysregulation Disorder
 - Anxiety, Social Anxiety, OCD
 - Severe ADHD
 - Oppositional Defiant & Conduct Disorders

The Psychiatric Advanced Practice Nurse

- Consultant to the SCHOOL
- Biweekly Schedule 6.5 hour/day
- Psychiatric Evaluations
- Crisis Evaluations
- Psychotropic Medication Management (if indicated)
- Referrals for Community Based MH Care
- Referrals for Additional Diagnostic & Medical Care
- Recommendations for higher levels of care

The Referral Question

Do the student's symptoms/behaviors

impact their ability to learn within the


educational environment?

The Results

- School Budgets +/- \$40,000 for Psychiatric APN Services
- Approximately 60 Unique Psychiatric Evaluations per year (since ~1995)
- Approximately 300 Medication Management Appointments (since 2022)
- Overall improved academic performance as well as "peaceful functioning at home"
- Maintained 25 students in-district
 - Saving District \$1,700,000 !!!
 - (Each out of district placement costs avg \$68,000)
- Reduced staff injuries
 - from 1 per day to 6 per YEAR

The Challenges

- Securing Sustainable Funding
 - Began as grant now built into budget
- School Resources
 - Mental health counselors
 - Behavioral analysts
- Specialized Programs
 - Autism programs
 - Behavioral disabilities programs
- Community Resources
 - Hospitals, Partial & Intensive Outpatient Programs
 - Residential Programs
 - Outpatient Treatment Providers (Therapists & Medication Management Providers)



Implications for Policy

- CDC promoting Mental Health & Well-Being in Schools
- Many States Legislating Mental Health Screening in Schools
- Developing Budget: Viewing Cost Savings as ++ ROI
- Psychiatric APNs Educating Schools on Services
- Connecting with Directors of Special Education
