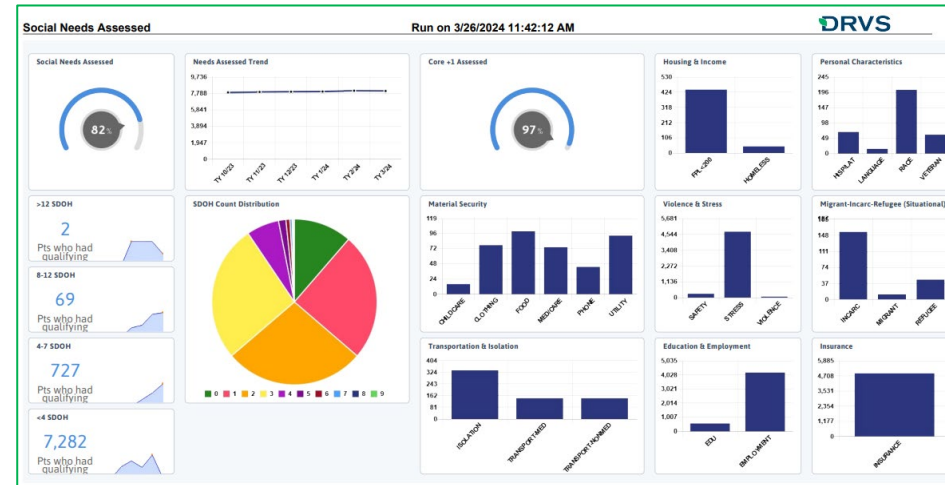

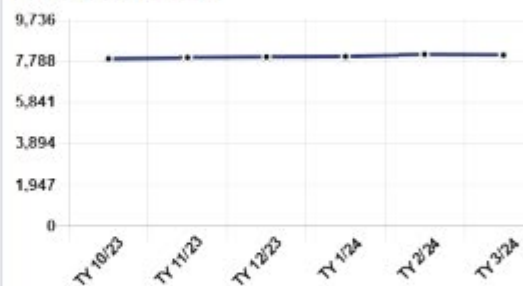

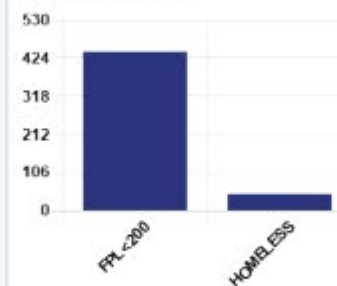

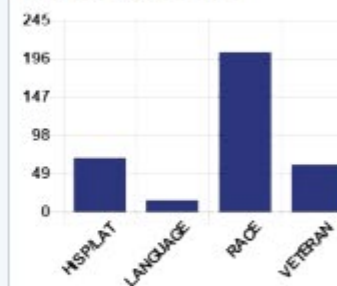

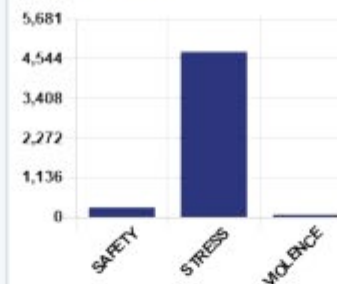
SDOH Count Distribution



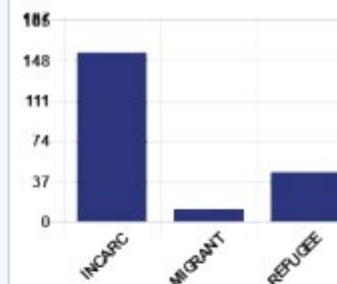

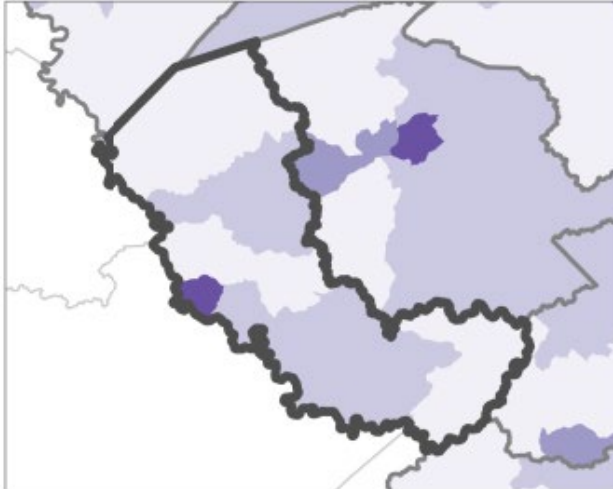
Socioeconomic Status⁵



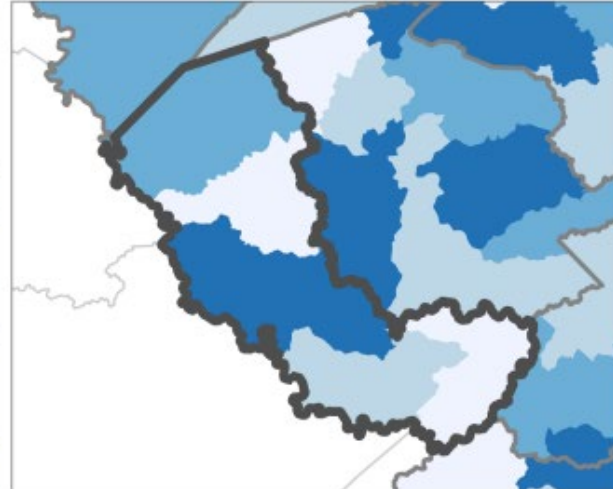

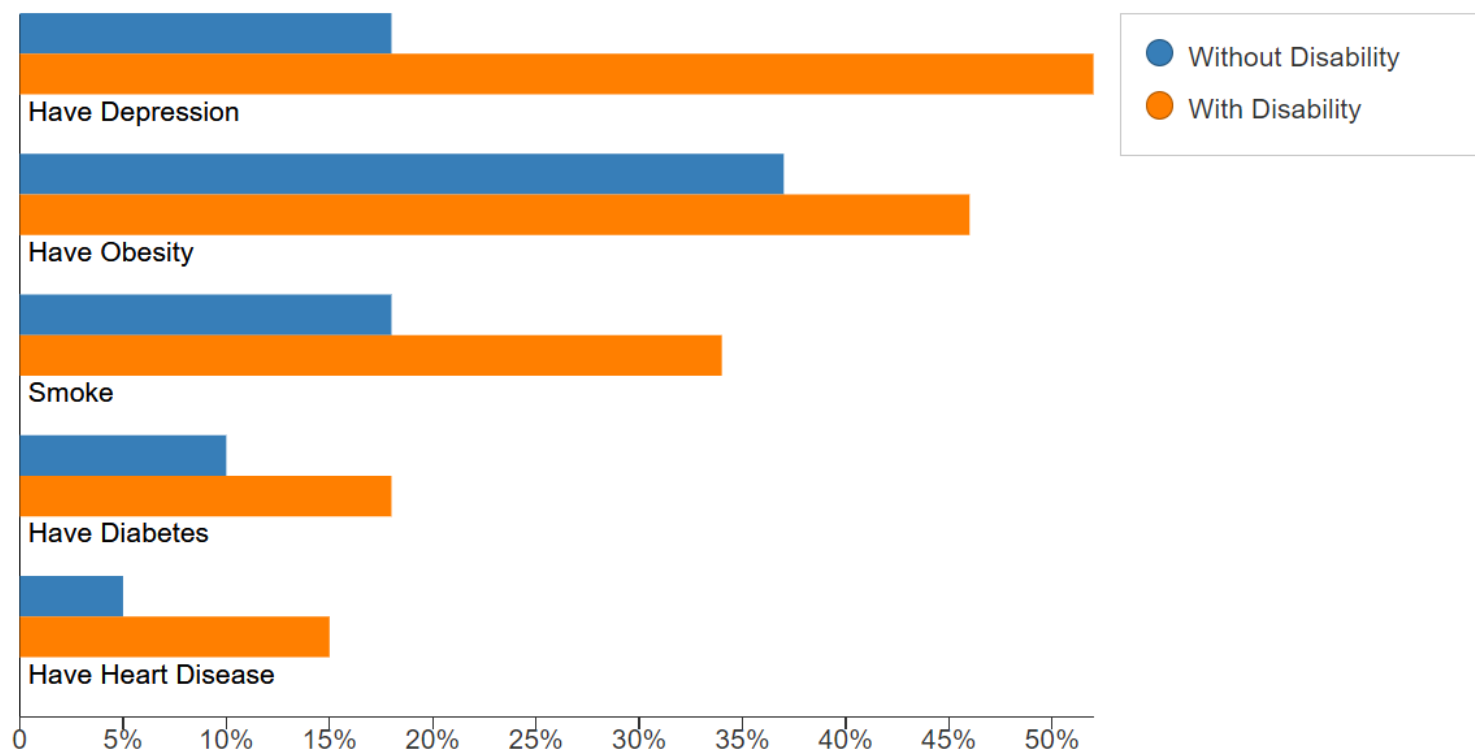

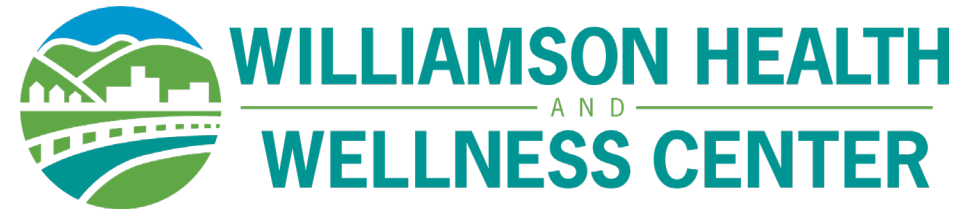
