

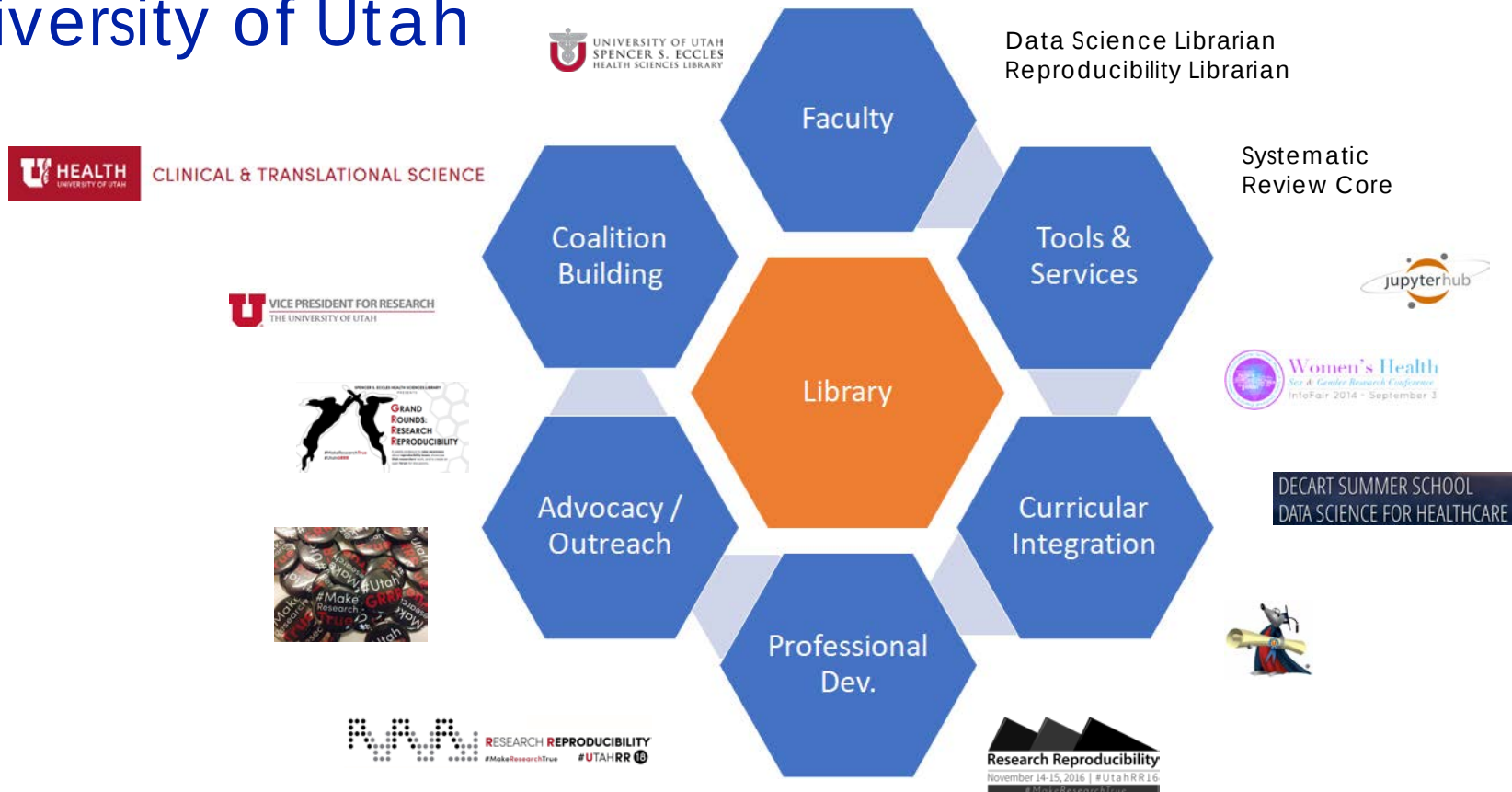
# An Institutional Perspective
