COVID-19 has fundamentally challenged the delivery of health care services worldwide, forcing difficult choices on health professionals and laying bare many preexisting health, medical, and public health sector frailties. This National Academies workshop series will re-explore previous IOM Crisis Standards of Care recommendations in light of ongoing lessons from the COVID-19 pandemic, with a particular focus on disaster planning, legal and equity considerations, and staffing considerations.

In the second virtual workshop of the series, expert panelists will specifically:

- Define key stakeholders' staffing needs (e.g., roles and responsibilities) during planning, activation, implementation, and evaluation/monitoring of CSC
