**Defining Terms** 

Race refers to a group sharing some outward physical characteristics and some commonalities of culture and history.

DEthnicity refers to markers acquired from the group with which one shares cultural, traditional, and familial bonds

**Defining Terms** 

☐ Biomedical Research is the broad area of science that looks for ways to prevent, the diseases that cause illness and death in people and in animals. This general field of research includes many areas of both life and physical sciences.

☐ Historically, research has...

Rarely directly benefited and sometimes actually harmed the communities involved

 Excluded affected communities from influence over the research process

Historically, research has...

- ☐Resulted in understandable distrust of, and reluctance to participate in, research
- ☐ Been labeled by communities as parachute, helicopter or drive-by research
- Led to interventions that are not tailored to the concerns & cultures of participants, and focused narrowly on individual behavior change







Commonly Held Beliefs Include:

- ☐The process being used against us
- ☐ Possible Exploitation
- ☐The 'guinea pig' complex

Five Commonly shared Arears of Concern:

- ☐ Mistrust or distrust of doctors
- ☐ Mistrust or distrust of scientists
- ☐ The unethical conduct of clinicians and investigators
- ☐ Being misinformed
- □Informed consent


- ☐ A space where you not only show respect but where you are respected...
